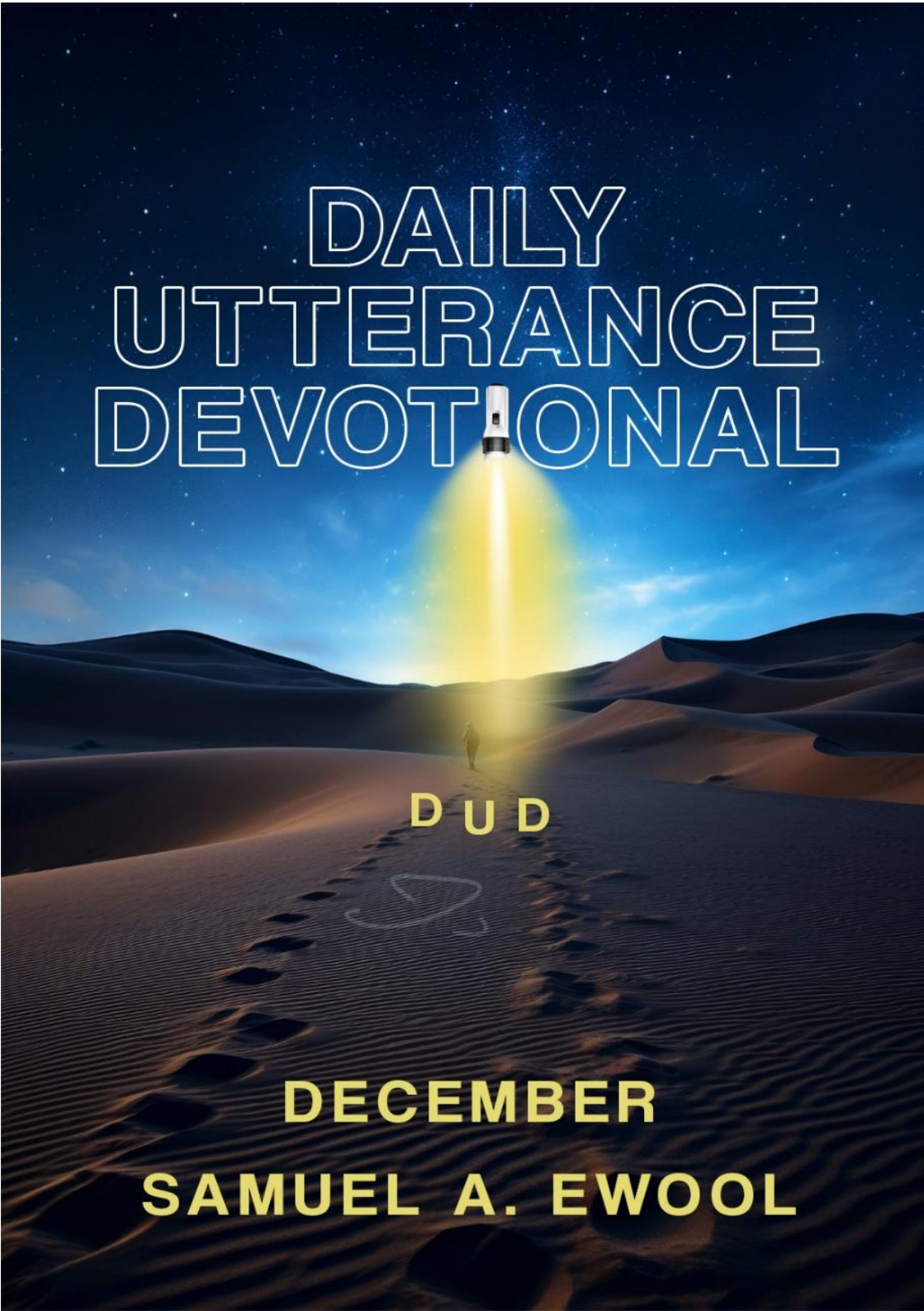

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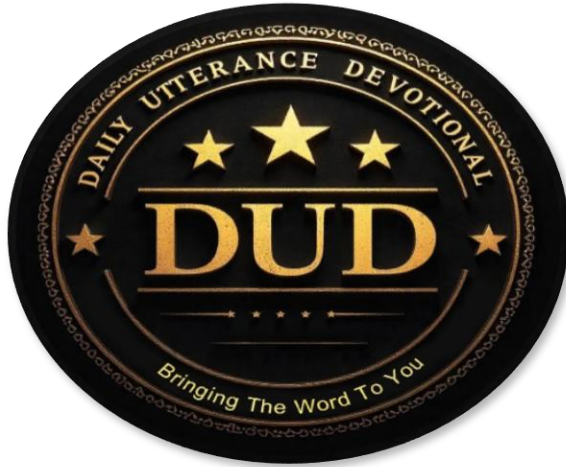

- 2. Proverbs 4:20-22** My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. 21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. 22 For ***they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.***

Confession: The Word of God is life to me and health to my flesh. The Word is medicine to my body. As I receive and meditate on the Word, I remain healthy and fresh. The Word is life to me. In Jesus' name. Amen.

- 3. 1 Peter 2:24** Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: ***by whose stripes ye were healed.***

2. 1 Timothy 2:15 Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety. 1Ti 2:15 But she shall be preserved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and love and holiness with discretion (DBY). 1Ti 2:15 But if they go on in faith and love and holy self-control, she will be kept safe at the time of childbirth (BBE).

Confession: As I continue in faith and love and holiness, I cannot suffer during childbirth. I shall give birth safely. It is God's promise to me and God never breaks His promise. I am kept safe. Ex 1:18 And the king of Egypt sent for the women, and said to them, Why have you done this, and let the male children go on living? 19 And they said to Pharaoh, Because ***the Hebrew women are not like the Egyptian women, for they are strong, and the birth takes place before we come to them.*** 20 And the blessing of God was on these women: and the people were increased in number and became very strong.

Confession: The Hebrew women were the children of God and their delivery was different from the Egyptian women. Same way I am also a child of God so my delivery is faster,

easier and safer than the normal natural woman because I am a child of God. I am strong. I am full of Divine life. Hallelujah!!! In Jesus' name. Amen.

4. Gal 3: 12 And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them. **13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law**, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: 14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Confession: Christ has redeemed us from every curse including Eve's curse. That is the excessive pains in child birth. I declare less pain in my child birth. Safe delivery and quick delivery. In Jesus' name. Amen.

***PRAYER:** Father, I thank you for the power in your Word and the power in my tongue. As I confess your Word by faith, it is happening for me in Jesus' name. Amen.*

HIS WORD CAUSES YOU TO DO GOOD WORKS

Col 1:9 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God.

In our anchor scripture, Apostle Paul prayed for the Church that they would be filled with the knowledge of God's will (the Word). One effect of the prayer was that they will be fruitful in every good work. When you are full of God's Word you will be full of His works.

Primarily, the Word builds your form to do good works. You cannot do good works if you have not been built up. The quantum of good works you can do is proportional to the form you have built. Recall that we have been ordained unto good works in Christ (***Eph 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them***). It is ordained for you in Christ to work

good works and it is your duty as a good Christian to discover them and fulfil them. You need the Word of God to prepare you and make you fruitful in these good works.

In conclusion, we are supposed to work good works in Christ to the glory of God our Father. Discover these good works and walk in them.

PRAYER: *Father, I thank you for your Word today. I thank you for revealing to me the power in your Word to cause me to be fruitful in good works. I pray that I will discover every good work ordained for me in Christ and fulfil them to the glory of God our Father in Jesus' name. Amen.*

Sunday

14th December, 2025.

THE CONTINUAL INFILLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Eph 5:18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; The verse below shows us how to achieve this. 19 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; 20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; 21 Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

Every Christian has the Holy Spirit in him/her. We received the Holy Spirit the day we were born again. In fact, the Holy Spirit is the life of God in us. Usually, when people read scriptures that talk about the infilling of the Holy Spirit, they get confused because they think that if the Holy Spirit is in us then we do not need any infilling of the same spirit. However, the continual infilling of the Holy Spirit is crucial for living a victorious Christian life full of signs and wonders.

In our anchor scripture, Paul talked about being filled with the Spirit. To be filled with the Spirit simply means to be under the

full control or influence of the Holy Spirit just like how someone behaves when he is drunk with wine. When someone takes in more wine the person becomes dominated by the influence of the alcohol which will cause him to behave differently. Similarly, when a Christian is filled with the Holy Spirit, he/she remains under the full control and domination of the Spirit such that he/she behaves just as God wants him/her to behave.

Again, in our anchor scripture, Apostle Paul shows us how to be constantly filled with the Holy Spirit. He admonishes us to speak to ourselves (this has to deal with you personally). Thus, these things must be done to your own self (***Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; 20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ***). Then to one another we must also submit ourselves.

SUPERNATURAL ENCOUNTERS: The Introduction

Exodus 3:1 Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb. 2 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. 3 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. 4 And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. 5 And he said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground.

Supernatural encounters can be described in several contexts but in this series, we are going to discuss supernatural encounters in the context of a physical appearance or a tangible appearance where one will acknowledge that the experience was supernatural but capturable by the physical senses. Thus, we are looking at encounters where God and/or His angels manifest in a way that

seem physical. Some examples in the Bible include: Moses and the burning bush, Paul's encounter at Damascus, Jacob and the angel of the Lord, etc.

This series is not a rigid plan for such supernatural encounters. Thus, there may not be a strict direct formula for God or His angels to manifest this way to a Christian (in an encounter form). However, there are keys that can prepare you as a fertile ground for such supernatural encounters.

In conclusion, these types of encounters may not necessarily be a sign of high spirituality but one cannot deny the impact of such encounters in the life of a Christian. It is important to bear in mind that it is in the sovereign power of God to manifest in the way He wants to a person. Recalling the words of Apostle Paul in ***Romans 9:16 So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy.*** Give yourself to the keys that will be studied in this series and leave the rest to God.

Again, in seeking God you should have a passionate hunger and thirst for Him to the point that no price is too high for you to pay to encounter His presence.

In conclusion, as you seek God with your whole heart, you must love Him more than anything (***Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me***).

Key 3: Engaging the Practicing of His Presence

- ii.** Engaging in quiet time (time alone with God in deep solicitude and contemplations- Psalms 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth).
- iii.** Fellowshiping with the Word through meditation (the Word in your heart, mind and mouth).

- iv. Fellowshiping in Prayer, especially praying in the Holy Spirit.
- v. Fellowshiping in Fasting and Retreats: ***Isa 40:31 But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.***
- vi. Fellowshiping in songs, psalms, hymns and making melody in your heart unto the Lord (Eph 5:18-20).
- vii. Fellowshiping with the Body of Christ: We must not neglect the assembling of the saints together (Hebrews 10:25). The assembling of the saints is a place where God manifests Himself. Also, as the body of Christ, we communicate and share in fellowship with one another.

In conclusion, these practices fine tune your spirit to attract supernatural encounters. Learn to stay in active fellowship with God each day by engaging these practices.

James 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

From our first anchor scripture, we can deduce that the extent to which one can drink is set by the person. Thus, you determine how much you want to drink and the rate at which you want to drink. You must be very thirsty to pant after the Lord. In the second anchor scripture, apostle James also reveals a similar truth that if we draw nigh to God, He will draw nigh to us. You must go the extra mile in your pursuit of God. The question is how thirsty are you.

Key 5: The Key of Purity and Holiness

2Ti 2:21 If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.

Without holiness one cannot see God. You must live a holy life as we have been born to be holy. Purge yourself from the works of the flesh to attract supernatural encounters. Sin is of the devil so the more you practice sin, the more you attract Satan and demons into your life. On the other hand, God is holy so as you set yourself apart for Him, you are inevitably preparing yourself as a fertile ground for divine encounters.

In conclusion, practice these two keys to prepare you for supernatural encounters. Pay the price for more of God, set yourself apart to be holy and walk in purity.

Key 7: Honouring envoys of God's Presence

Honour people who are envoys of God's manifest presence. Consider the following scripture; ***1 Samuel 19:18 So David fled, and escaped, and came to Samuel to Ramah, and told him all that Saul had done to him. And he and Samuel went and dwelt in Naioth. 19 And it was told Saul, saying, Behold, David is at Naioth in Ramah. 20 And Saul sent messengers to take David: and when they saw the company of the prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing as appointed over them, the Spirit of God was upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied. 21 And when it was told Saul, he sent other messengers, and they prophesied likewise. And Saul sent messengers again the third***

time, and they prophesied also. 22 Then went he also to Ramah, and came to a great well that is in Sechu: and he asked and said, Where are Samuel and David? And one said, Behold, they be at Naioth in Ramah. 23 And he went thither to Naioth in Ramah: and the Spirit of God was upon him also, and he went on, and prophesied, until he came to Naioth in Ramah. 24 And he stripped off his clothes also, and prophesied before Samuel in like manner, and lay down naked all that day and all that night. Wherefore they say, Is Saul also among the prophets? In this scripture, we observe something spectacular that within the circumference of Samuel, one cannot afford than to prophesy. It means Samuel was a carrier of a certain dimension of God. Also, Moses spent so much time in the presence of God that his face was shining with light. When you honour carriers of God's manifest presence you are also ushered into similar atmospheres and encounters.

In conclusion, God is everywhere but His manifest presence does not carelessly show up everywhere. It is atmosphere dependent. It must be passionately desired, consistently pursued and persistently contended for.

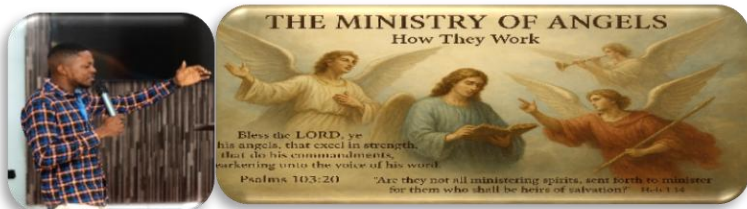
In God's order of creation, angels were created with certain abilities higher than the natural man but the redeemed man (new

THE MINISTRY OF ANGELS: How to Activate Angelic Ministrations

As you meditate on the Word (the highest peak being speaking), you condition a climate for angelic operations and ministrations. After Jesus overcame the temptation of the devil by the Word of God three times, angels came and ministered to him (***Matthew 4:11 Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him***). Our words in line with the Word of God are spirit and life (***John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life***). What we say is what we get. Our words give birth to our present happenings.

3. **Activating the ministry of angels through maturity in Christ:** ***Eph 3:10 To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God***. The number of angels a believer can command increases as he or she matures. Angels assigned to you reflect your level of maturity and operation.

In conclusion, we have innumerable company of angels to help us each day. The Christian is on the victorious side. There are more with us than with them. We cannot be defeated. Walk in this consciousness and you will always be on top.

Psalms 44:3 For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them.

In our previous study, we understood that the earth belongs to our Lord. In today's study we want to consider one of the ways God makes His children to possess the land as their inheritance.

In our anchor scripture, the people of Israel possessed the land because God favoured them. In conclusion, pray for the expression of the Lord's favour upon your life for kingdom cause and not for fleshy desires. Let us possess the land for our Lord.

In conclusion, we must rely on the Word of God as our assurance. What the Word declares is what we must believe and rely on. The Word truly works. If we ask, we will surely receive.
