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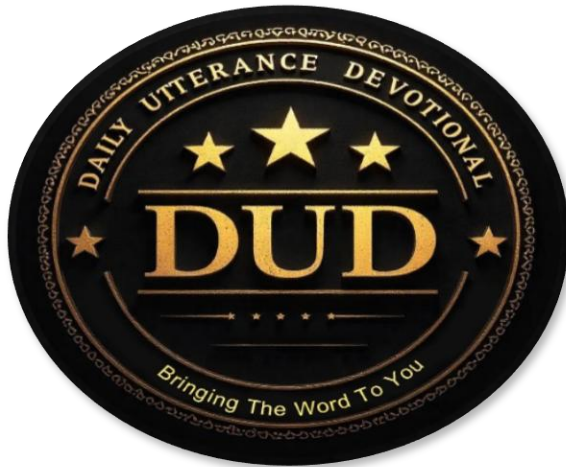
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INTRODUCTION

PROMPT OBEDIENCE

Genesis 22:1 And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, here I am. 2 And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of. 3 And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.

In our anchor scripture, we see Abraham's reaction after God's instruction. Thus, he rose up early in the morning to go and fulfill the command of God. Prompt obedience to God's instruction is a clear sign of faith and absolute dependence on God.

In this new year, you must be willing to obey God's commands and instructions. Make it a point to be prompt in obeying. Delayed obedience is often considered as a form of disobedience.

Moreover, if you delay in obeying, you may perhaps be delaying the purposes of God in your life for which cause God has instructed you to do something.

In conclusion, be malleable to the leadings of the Holy Spirit this year and swiftly obey His promptings. You may perhaps be saving yourself or others. Prompt obedience is always a blessing.

SIGNS AND WONDERS

Hebrews 2:4 God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?

A sign is a visible indication (a sign points to something) whilst a wonder is something that causes amazement or awe or a marvel. A wonder imparts reverence to men about God. Signs and wonders together validates the claim that God exists.

As Christians we are to reveal the reality of Christ to a perverse world and we cannot do that without signs and wonders. In this postmodern world of relativism and subjectivity where every claim about God and Christ can be contested, we cannot just preach only the Word but we must demonstrate the Spirit with signs and wonders.

Remember that, the easiest way to prove that someone is alive is to call out the person's name and receive a response from him or her. Hence, if Jesus is alive, we must be able to mention His name in certain predicaments of men and He must respond.

We must contend to walk in literal signs and wonders to proof that Jesus is alive. God (the Holy Spirit) who is the eternal witness of the resurrection of Christ is willing and readily available to partner with us to bear witness of Jesus (*Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth*).

In conclusion the power of the Holy Spirit is to make us witnesses of the resurrection of Jesus with signs and wonders (Acts 4:33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all).

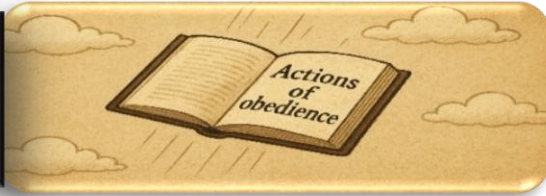
HOW TO MANIFEST SIGNS AND WONDERS – PART 1

- 1. The Presence of the Lord: *Mark 16:20 And they went forth, and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.*** The consciousness of your partnership with the Lord is crucial for walking in signs and wonders. You must be fully captured by the reality that you are not alone. For with Him, all things are possible. The Holy Spirit is the one who makes the presence of Jesus so real to us. In fact, the Holy Spirit is the presence of Jesus to us. In partnership with Him there will be signs following us.
- 2. By the force of Prayer: *Acts 4:30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. 31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled***

together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. Prayer is a sure way of calling divine intervention. When God manifests, there are great signs and wonders. The results of the prayer of the Apostles showed that prayer causes a move of God (***Acts 4:33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all).***

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus, we thank you for your Word today. We pray that by today's study, may we learn to walk in signs and wonders. Father, grant me grace to contend for the manifestation of more signs and wonders in my Christian journey in Jesus' name.*

Acts 6:8 And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people.

3. **Manifesting signs and wonders through Faith:** There are three major things to do in the journey of faith for signs and wonders to be produced.
 - i. You must encounter the Word: *Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.*
 - ii. You must meditate on the Word till you know your role to play: *Joshua 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.*
 - iii. You must take actions of obedience: *James 2:17 Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. 18 Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my*

faith by my works. 20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? So, you must align with what the word of God is saying and do your part.

In conclusion, what you believe determines the signs that follow you (***Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover***). We can enjoy the divine possibilities available to us in Christ if only we can believe the Word of God and take actions of faith towards them.

PRAYER: Father in the name of Jesus, we thank you for your Word today. We pray that you cause us to desire your Word to grow our faith and thereby manifest signs and wonders in Jesus' name. Amen.

MIRACLES

Acts 2:22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know:

In today's study, we will consider another closely related factor that validates the claim that Jesus resurrected and is alive. That is; miracles done in the name of the Lord.

In our anchor scripture, Apostle Peter declared that Jesus' earthly walk was approved by God with signs, wonders and miracles. So, as He is not physically here on the earth, we ought to prove that He is alive by miracles, signs and wonders. No wonder Jesus said greater works shall we do (John 14:12).

A miracle is an event that appears inexplicable or unexplainable by the laws of nature or by the ways of men and as such it is believed to be supernatural in origin. A genuine miracle

testifies about Jesus and stirs up faith in people as revealed by the following scriptures:

John 6:14 Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

John 2:23 Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast day, many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did.

John 6:2 And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased.

When they saw the miracles, they believed. There are some people unless they see a miracle, they will not believe in our Lord Jesus. Same way, the early church testified about Jesus with miracles, signs and wonders. Miracles were part of their testimony; they were not just preachers but miracle workers (***Acts 4:33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all***).

CONFESSION: *I thank you Father for your word today. Father, let my life be full of miracles to validate that Jesus is indeed alive. I am a miracle and miracles are happening everyday as I walk with God in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ARE MIRACLES FOR ALL CHRISTIANS?

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

In our first anchor scripture, the power of the Holy Spirit is for all believers to become witnesses.

There are wonderful questions to ponder over in our second anchor scripture;

- Has Jesus gone to the father?
- Did Jesus work miracles?
- The works Jesus did were miracles part of them?
- Did Jesus say only the Apostles will do that work or anyone that believes?

- Are we to do the works He did (in this context miracles) and even greater than what he did?

Our two anchor scriptures point to the fact that all Christians are supposed to walk in the miraculous.

Although some people have been given the gift of working of miracles (***1Cor 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. 9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; 10 To another the working of miracle***) but we are all supposed to walk in the miraculous. Remember that there is also the gift of faith but are we all supposed to live by faith. So, inevitably, the gift is for specialization and it is to be used for the benefit of all (that is why we are the body of Christ). However, miracles are for all Christians. We are all supposed to walk in the miraculous.

PRAYER: *Father we thank you for your Word today. I believe in miracles. Father, cause me to experience miracles daily in my life as a Christian in Jesus' name. Amen.*

HOW TO WALK IN THE MIRACULOUS – PART 1

In our previous study, we agreed that we are all supposed to walk in the miraculous and as such it is expedient that we learn some keys on how to walk in the miraculous.

1. Grow intimate with God: (*John 3:2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him*). Nicodemus knew that it is only the presence of God with a man that can make him achieve supernatural results. You must know that with the God of all possibilities on our side everything is possible. Thus, the supernatural becomes our natural estate. The consciousness of our partnership with the Lord is crucial for walking in miracles. We must be fully captured by the reality that we are not alone. The Holy Spirit is the Father in Spirit and actually the presence of the Father to us. In partnership with Him we will walk in miracles for He is the power and life of God.

2. Walk in Faith: *Acts 6:8 And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people.* A Christian cannot work miracles without walking in faith. Stephen full of faith worked miracles. It takes faith to declare upon the sick for them to experience healing miracles.

Paul argued that even receiving the Spirit (eternal life: the zoe) is by hearing the gospel and taking steps of faith (confessing Jesus as Lord). He further talks about working of miracles and he attributes that also to the hearing of faith (the hearing of the word or gospel) for faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God (*Gal 3:5 He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?*).

PRAYER: *Father we thank you for your Word today. I believe in miracles. Father, cause me to experience miracles daily in my life as a Christian in Jesus' name. Amen.*

3. Righteousness and Right Living, Holiness and Practical

Holiness: *John 9:16 Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. Others said, How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles? And there was a division among them.* A sinner (by nature and practice) cannot work genuine miracles. Unbelievers cannot work miracles (God-kind of miracles). A Christian by nature is righteous so he/she has the full opportunity to work miracles but if he/she continues to live by the flesh (practice sin) he or she cannot manifest the Spirit. So, we must crucify the flesh and walk in the Spirit (living right). On the other hand, Holiness talks about uncommonness or dedication. We are a holy nation (God's special people). However, to live out this holiness in a practical way, you must consciously live a life dedicated to God and His word (practical holiness). An aspect of practical Holiness has to deal with customized dealings God has for only you. For instance; God can tell you to pray at 2am every day, and when you are faithful and obedient to that dealing you may begin to see the

results of that dealing in your life (supernatural benefits: miracles). To follow your customized dealings with God is a form of practical holiness and these dealings are not doctrinal for every Christian but they are personal for your own walk with God. Living in practical holiness is a key for experiencing the miraculous in your life. Learn to hear God's voice and obey his instructions in every aspect of your life.

PRAYER: *Father we thank you for your Word today. I pray that through these keys may I begin to walk in the miraculous. I am a miracle and miracles are happening every day in my life in Jesus' name. Amen.*

4. The consciousness of the ministry of angels:

The book of Acts is clear on some irrefutable manifestations of angels and the roles they played in the working of miracles. Some examples are:

Acts 12:5 Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him. 6 And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison. 7 And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon him, and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from his hands..... 11 And when Peter was come to himself, he said, Now I know of a surety, that the Lord hath sent his angel, and hath delivered me out of the hand of Herod, and from all the expectation of the people of the Jews.

Acts 5:18 And laid their hands on the apostles, and put them in the common prison. 19 But the angel of the Lord by night

opened the prison doors, and brought them forth, and said, 20 Go, stand and speak in the temple to the people all the words of this life.

You have to be conscious of the presence of angels and their roles in the lives of Christians. You must activate their ministry in your life to experience miracles. You can simply activate their ministry by speaking the word of God, through prayer and by maturing in Christ.

In conclusion, miracles are real and every believer is supposed to walk in the miraculous. Until the supernatural becomes our natural estate experientially, we must not stop contending for more, no matter the price.

The Lord desires that His children become successful. The Biblical way of success is holistic. That is; we must succeed in all areas of our lives. The worldly system permits success in some areas of one's life at the detriment of the person's peace of mind, and the health of the body and/or soul of the individual. For instance; the devil or the world can make someone successful financially but the person may suffer spiritually. Some people have also sold their peace to the devil for success. But the Christian way of success, is to be successful in all aspects of one's life. Christ is the way. True success and peace are found ***Only in Christ***. The first step for true/kingdom success for any natural man is to be born again. However, as Christians, there are key areas in our lives that we must make sure to succeed:

1. Our Spiritual Life: We must be successful in the following areas:

- i. **Intimacy with the Spirit:** *2 Cor 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen.*

Engage in active fellowship with the Holy Spirit every day. Get to know Him intimately.

- ii. **Spiritual maturity:** *Eph 4:13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ. You must grow to become like Christ.*
- iii. **The fruit of the Spirit:** *Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. Make a decision to bear fruit. Succeed in bearing the fruit of the Spirit daily.*

Success in your spiritual life

- iv. Manifesting the life of God:** *Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.* Manifesting the life and power of God is not for pastors but for every believer. The Holy Spirit (the custodian of the power of God) came that we will be witnesses of Jesus Christ. Demonstrating the power and life of God proves that Jesus is alive (*Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth*).

- v. **Your engagement in Spiritual disciplines** like word study, Bible reading, prayers, fasting, dancing, worshipping, singing, praising, thanksgiving, shouting and clapping unto the Lord, etc. You must be successful in this area.
- vi. **Your work specifically in your local church:** You must excel there. You can do something no matter who you are in the church or what work you have been given. Have a vision to work in at least one department of your church and excel there. Contribute to making it better. Some young people are fond of leaving their local churches after getting to the university but I believe you can equally carry the new things you experience on campus to your local churches to transform them.
- vii. **Your spiritual gifts:** *1 Cor 12:7-But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.* Have a vision of sharpening your gifts to the end that others will profit from them. Be successful in using your gifts.

- ❖ The soul winning business - 2Cor 5:18 *And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation.*
- ❖ The discipleship business - Matt 28:19 *"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen. (NKJV).*

We must excel in the general purposes of a Christian.

- ii. ***The Specific Purpose of a believer:*** This a product of your Spiritual life. If your spiritual life is intact, it is easy to discover your specific assignment in life. It is worthy to note that your career can be a means to fulfilling your

purpose. That is, it gives you the opportunity (creates a room for you to fulfill your divine assignment) in the corporate world. You must be successful in fulfilling your divine assignment. In fact, that is how you will live a fulfilled life. Have a desire that one day you will sit back and say to yourself I have served my generation and impacted my society through my God-given purpose.

Strive to excel and be very successful in your specific assignment. You will be rewarded for the value you carry and the impact you are making in any area of your life.

Whatever you are doing, add more value to yourself. Become very skilful at it. Your skill will sell you. Remember that the success of anything is dependent on how valuable that thing is to many people on earth (the customer-based system). One man said, there are things if you have poor people will look for you, there are things if you have rich people may look for you but there are things if you have all men will seek for you. Become so skillful in whatever you are doing that all men will seek for that product or service or talent or gifts, etc you possess.

In conclusion, the pillars of success are the support systems for a long-lasting successful life. Keep solidifying these pillars of success in your life for a durable successful life.

However, the same concept of training is the foundation for all these four terms.

In conclusion, mentorship is a ladder for success. We are trained in the kingdom to become successful. Every making is by training.

- 1. Moses and Joshua:** Joshua effectively took over from Moses. He was mentored by Moses and hence led the people well. However, the Israelites entered into the period of the Judges because Joshua did not mentor anyone to take over from him. This leadership gap could have been avoided if Joshua trained/mentored someone to succeed him.

In our anchor scripture we observe that Joshua was mentored as he was serving Moses. Service is one of the simplest ways to be mentored by your mentor/shepherd/spiritual father/discipler.

In mentorship, there is impartation of graces which will cause you to be successful as your mentor (***Deut 34:9 And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him, and did as the LORD commanded Moses).***

Joshua was ready to lead the people of Israel after he was fully imparted by his mentor. So, his leadership started right after the death of Moses (***Joshua 1:1 Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying...***).

Jesus, the master mentor taught them the Word of God for three and half years before baptizing them with the Holy Spirit. It is

important in the process of mentorship that we are taught the Word of God first before we are imparted with grace. A gifted rebel is not an asset to the kingdom. Teachings ground people in the faith.

Again, the master Jesus gave them practical training in the ministry by sending them to preach the gospel (***Luke 10:1 After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come. 17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name***). True mentorship must have practical sessions to help mentees have a first-hand experience of what they are being taught.

In conclusion, the master Jesus showed us a complete template for mentoring people. That is; by teaching, practical training and impartation of the Spirit. Let's mentor/disciple souls for the kingdom because that is the great commission (Matthew 28:18-20).

In conclusion, there are clear examples of mentorship in the New Testament and I believe any serious Christian should have a mentor/shepherd/spiritual father/shepherd whose role is to help him/her grow in Christ and fulfil destiny.

And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me...* 11 *And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven. 12 And Elisha saw it, and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces*). Through service, one can practically learn from his/her mentors/spiritual fathers/shepherds/disciplers.

In conclusion, mentorship is a ladder for success. We must thrive on the sacrifices and labours of our mentors/spiritual fathers/shepherds/disciplers to rise in life. Mark 6:1 And he went out from thence, and came into his own country; and his disciples follow him. 2 And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing him were astonished, saying, From whence hath this man these things? and what wisdom is this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands? 3 Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him. 4 But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house. 5 And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. 6 And

he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.

You must believe in the person who you wish to receive from. That belief in the grace he or she carries is an honour. This is why not believing God is a form of dishonour to Him. In our anchor scripture, our Lord and master Jesus revealed how their unbelief was a dishonour to him and as such he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them.

Unbelief is a sign of dishonour and you can never receive from God or any carrier of the grace of God if you do not believe that they have what you want. ***2 Ch 20:20 And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.***

Believe in the men God send into your life and thou shall be established. Believe them as vessels God has sent to reach you. They are not your source but you cannot deny that they are the conduits through which God will reach you.

becomes difficult for him or her to bless you. This is unprofitable for your rising. An obedient child easily receives blessings. In conclusion, submission shows that you hold the other in high esteem which is a demonstration of honour.

Psalms 66:1 Make a joyful noise unto God, all ye lands: 2 Sing forth the honour of his name: make his praise glorious (honour to God).

Matthew 11:11 Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.

Anyone you wish to honour you must learn to speak well of the person both in private and in public. In our second anchor scripture, Jesus spoke well of John the Baptist publicly. Remember it was John the Baptist who publicly declared Jesus to be the lamb of God. Jesus demonstrated great honour to the one who baptized him by speaking well of him in public. Even when John was offended in him, Jesus did not dishonour him. Learn to celebrate and speak well of the great. It is an honour unto them. Learn to speak well of the people you intend to honour. Do not

speaking evil behind them. Stop gossiping and murmuring. Your thoughts are vocal in the realms of the Spirit so do not think evil for them.

On another note, some youths are fond of not celebrating their parents in the sight of their friends but you must learn to celebrate your parents everywhere you go (honour to parents).

In conclusion, honour by celebrating in public and private is an important key of showing honour. Learn to also celebrate the Lord in all things both in private and public. We must show honour to God first before men.

HONOURING THROUGH OUR SUBSTANCE

Proverbs 3:9 Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase: 10 So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

Anyone you wish to honour you must learn to show it through your substance. Honour God by your substance. Learn to honour men of God, spiritual parents, biological parents and great people we wish to receive from. Honouring through substance is the basic practical way of showing that you hold someone in high esteem. There are many scriptures that point to the fact that we must honour through substance. 1Cor 9:9 For it is written in the law of Moses, Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of the ox that treadeth out the corn. Doth God take care for oxen? 10 Or saith he it altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, this is written: that he that ploweth should plow in hope; and that he that thresheth in hope should be partaker of his hope. 11 If we have sown unto

you spiritual things, is it a great thing if we shall reap your carnal things? 12 If others be partakers of this power over you, are not we rather? Nevertheless we have not used this power; but suffer all things, lest we should hinder the gospel of Christ. 13 Do ye not know that they which minister about holy things live of the things of the temple? and they which wait at the altar are partakers with the altar? 14 Even so hath the Lord ordained that they which preach the gospel should live of the gospel.

Gal 6:6 Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things. 7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap (KJV). Ga 6:6 But let him who gets teaching in the word give a part in all good things to his teacher. 7 Be not tricked; God is not made sport of: for whatever seed a man puts in, that will he get back as grain (BBE).

Philippians 4:17 Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account.

Matthew 10:41 He that receiveth a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward; and he that receiveth a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward.

Honouring the servants of God is very powerful to release graces for a successful life. You must also learn to honour your parents

through your substance. Some people never give to their parents. It is a big error. Honour your parents by making them live comfortable lives. Give them gifts, money, etc. Extend the honour through substance to all men where necessary.
