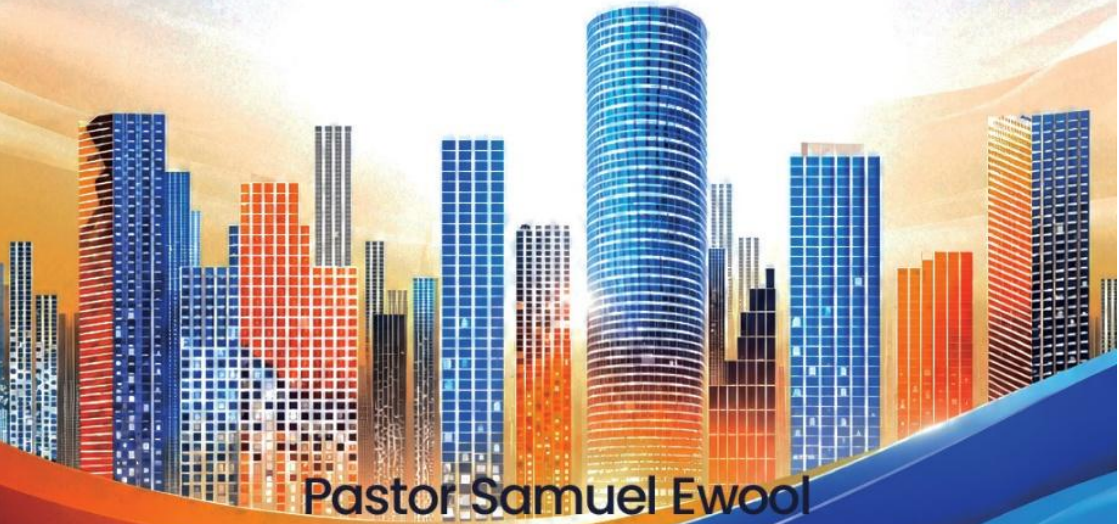

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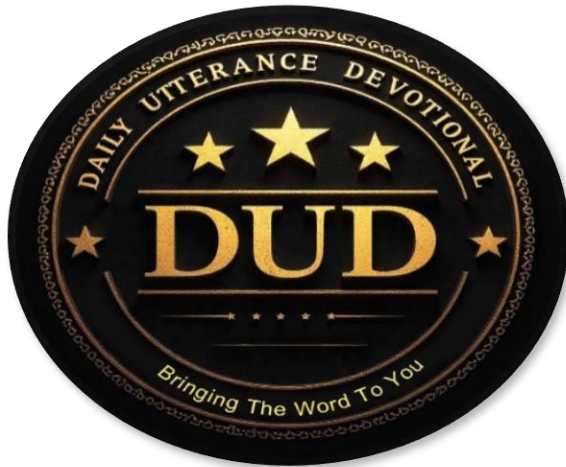

ENLARGEMENT SERIES: The Introduction

1 Chronicles 4:9 And Jabez was more honourable than his brethren: and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, Because I bare him with sorrow.

10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.

Enlargement simply is an increase. In our anchor scripture, Jabez prayed to God to enlarge him and God granted him his request. God responds to a genuine desire for enlargement. God is a God of enlargement. Usually, whatever God wants to do with us starts small but it is expected to grow and enlarge (***Job 8:7 Though thy beginning was small, yet thy latter end should greatly increase***).

It is important to observe that, although the background of Jabez did not look appealing because his mother gave birth to him in

sorrow. However, his background story did not limit him from seeking for enlargement. It is God's desire for us to enlarge.

In conclusion, the end of whatever God has destined for us is great and it is supposed to serve others (***Luke 13:18 Then said he, Unto what is the kingdom of God like? and whereunto shall I resemble it? 19 It is like a grain of mustard seed, which a man took, and cast into his garden; and it grew, and waxed a great tree; and the fowls of the air lodged in the branches of it).***

In this month's devotional we are going to explore some strategies on how to be enlarged.

PRAYER: *Father, I thank you for your Word today. I pray that in this month's devotional you guide me to my place of enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ENLARGEMENT BY FIGHTING (PART 1)

2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Every enlargement has its related battles to fight. If you do not master warfare you cannot enlarge. In our first anchor scripture, Apostle Paul revealed that, the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty through God. This means that our warfare is spiritual and as such we must contend with the powers of darkness to enter into our place of enlargement. We must pull down strongholds, cast down imaginations and every high thing that exalts itself above the knowledge of God. This battle in the mind is important because as a man thinks so is he. Inevitably, if the

powers of darkness are able to keep a man under bondage in the mind he can never be enlarged.

As revealed by Apostle Paul in our second anchor scripture that we wrestle not against flesh and blood but against principalities, powers, the rulers of the darkness of this world and spiritual wickedness in high places, we must know that it is the desire of Satan and his cohorts for us to remain small without enlargement. We must contend through light to enforce our victory over the powers of darkness.

PRAYER: *Father, we pray that evil powers that do not want us to enlarge we overcome in Jesus' name. We declare that patterns and strongholds in our families that limit enlargement be broken. We pray that any man or woman that is saying he or she will not let us enlarge, we declare judgement upon him or her in Jesus' name.*

ENLARGEMENT BY FIGHTING. PART TWO

2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

In our anchor scriptures, Apostle Paul reveals our warfare with Satan and his cohorts. You must understand that, the moment you are born again you inherit a long age warfare with Satan and when you decide to enlarge you have signed up for a fiercer battle with the enemy. Thus, every Christian is a threat to the kingdom of darkness but Christians who seek for enlargement are the immediate targets of the enemy. Every enlargement you desire is a fight. However, through Jesus Christ we have the victory.

Jesus has already defeated the enemy and his cohorts and we are to walk in that victory all the days of our lives. Decide that no power on earth will stop you from enlargement. It is important to note here that, when you enlarge as a Christian in all aspects of your life, you can do more works in the kingdom and this inevitably will lead to kingdom advancement.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus we pray that evil forces that do not want us to enlarge we prevail over them.*

We pray that strongholds in our minds that limit enlargement be broken in Jesus' name. We pray that any tongue or gathering that is against our enlargement be condemned and scattered in Jesus' name. Amen.

ENLARGEMENT BY FIGHTING A GOOD FIGHT OF FAITH

Mark 9:23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

God is a God of enlargement. As God sends His word to us, we know that His word will surely be fulfilled and we shall be enlarged. However, it takes the spirit of faith to see the enlargement you desire. The vision of enlargement is bigger than your present level and it usually seems impossible to get there. So, you need faith to apprehend your enlargement.

In our first anchor scripture, our Lord Jesus emphasized that all things are possible to him that believes. Faith is the believer's currency for obtaining expected results.

In conclusion, fight the good fight of faith in order to fulfil your divine assignment and bring the Word of God to pass. Your enlargement is a faith journey. There is a crown for overcomers. Do not give up. Fight the good fight of faith.

ENLARGEMENT BY BUILDING SPIRITUAL CAPACITY (PART 1)

Spiritual Fervency

***Romans 12:11 Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit;
serving the Lord;***

Spiritual capacity is the bedrock for enlargement in life. One of the ways to build spiritual capacity is to maintain your spiritual fervency. Building your spiritual capacity is demanding. It involves a lot of spiritual work and labours. Inevitably, you need spiritual fervency to build your spiritual capacity. Spiritual fervency simply means an intense, passionate zeal for spiritual things. It is a wholehearted commitment to the things of the Spirit.

In our anchor scripture, Apostle Paul admonishes us to be fervent in spirit. We must fight to be on fire and committed to our walk with the Holy Spirit. This passion and full energy to pursue the Spirit and the things of God is what will cause you to be consistent in building your spiritual capacity.

You must understand that, enlargement comes with greater responsibilities and demands in the Spirit and as such spiritual capacity is needed to carry the weight of the enlargement.

Be fervent in the Spirit, a lot depends on it. You can be enlarged only to the degree that you have built the spiritual capacity to handle it.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus, we pray that you help us to build spiritual capacity for enlargement. We pray for the grace to pray, fast and soak in the Word constantly in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ENLARGEMENT BY BUILDING SPIRITUAL CAPACITY (PART 2).

Spiritual Stamina

Luke 6:12 And it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.

Acts 20:7 And upon the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight. 8 And there were many lights in the upper chamber, where they were gathered together. 9 And there sat in a window a certain young man named Eutychus, being fallen into a deep sleep: and as Paul was long preaching, he sunk down with sleep, and fell down from the third loft, and was taken up dead. 10 And Paul went down, and fell on him, and embracing him said, Trouble not yourselves; for his life is in him. 11 When he therefore was come up again, and had broken bread, and eaten, and talked a long while, even till break of day, so he departed. 12 And they brought the young man alive, and were not a little comforted.

Spiritual capacity is the bedrock for enlargement in life. In our previous study it was highlighted that building spiritual capacity

is demanding entailing diverse spiritual disciplines, labours and sacrifices.

It is important to note that because of the enormity of the demands of building spiritual capacity, there can be fatigue in our pursuit. However, we must have the spiritual stamina to continue to pursue spiritual capacity. In our first anchor scripture, Jesus continued in prayer throughout the whole night, this reveals His stamina in the things of the Spirit. His Spirit had the dominion over His flesh.

Also, in our second anchor scripture, we observe some dangers of not maintaining your spiritual stamina. As Paul taught the Word of God, the congregation were being built spiritually but Eutychus lacked the spiritual stamina to receive the Word and fell asleep. He fell down and almost died if not for the intervention of Apostle Paul. Lack of spiritual stamina can result in spiritual slumber and ultimately death (complete backsliding).

We must renew our strength by waiting on God to the end that our spiritual stamina will be retained as we pursue to build our spiritual capacity.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus, we pray that you help us to build spiritual capacity for enlargement. We pray for the grace and strength to continue to build the spiritual capacity needed for our enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

1 YEAR BIBLE READING PLAN: 2 Kings 5-8



Sunday

ENLARGEMENT BY PRAYER AND FASTING

Matthew 17:21 Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.

Luke 2:36 And there was one Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity; 37 And she was a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day.

Acts 13:2 As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them. 3 And when they had fasted and prayed, and laid their hands on them, they sent them away. 4 So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus.

Prayer and fasting is necessary for every enlargement. Every major move of God that brings enlargement is preceded by prayer. Jesus was born and preserved because some people were praying and fasting. In our second anchor scripture, Anna the prophetess prayed and fasted for the Messiah to be born after she

became a widow. I believe that, these prayers influenced the occurrence of the heightened angelic activities that surrounded the birth of Christ. Enlargement simply is fulfilling the Word of God concerning a person or a people that brings salvation and advancement. The coming of Christ was a season of enlargement.

In our third anchor scripture, Apostle Paul was enlarged in his ministry work after they prayed and fasted. The expansion of his mandate to the gentile world was preceded by fasting and prayers. Inevitably, every enlargement requires prayers and fasting.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus we pray that you stir us up unto prayer and fasting. Father, revive my prayer altar. We pray for grace and angelic assistance in prayer. We pray for enlargement in any area of concern in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ENLARGEMENT BY BUILDING INTELLECTUAL CAPACITY

Psalms 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. 2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. 3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

2 Timothy 4:13 The cloke that I left at Troas with Carpus, when thou comest, bring with thee, and the books, but especially the parchments.

It takes knowledge to be enlarged. There is no lasting enlargement without adequate sustained knowledge. Be a learner/reader every day and you will continue to enlarge every day. Peter said grace and peace be multiplied through the knowledge of God and our Lord Jesus Christ. You need knowledge to enlarge.

In our first anchor scripture, the psalmist revealed the life of a man who stays with the Word of God. He will continue to enlarge and bear fruits. If you desire enlargement you must stay with the Word of God every day.

In our second anchor scripture, we see how one of the greatest apostles in the New Testament had a great affection and connection with knowledge to the end that he instructed his son Timothy to bring him his books. You must build your intellectual capacity if you desire to be enlarged.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus we pray that you stir in us the appetite and hunger to read more books. More grace to learn/read. We pray for revelation and understanding on how to enlarge in our area as we engage the pursuit of knowledge. May we read the right books. We pray for connections and associations that will encourage us to read in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ENLARGEMENT BY SECRETS

Psalms 25:14 The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.

De 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law.

There are secrets for enlargement. You may just need to know the strategy. There are secrets which God can show you for your enlargement.

The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will show them his covenant. The secrets for our enlargement are with God and when we walk in the fear of God, He will show us the secrets. The fear of God is holding God in high esteem in your daily life.

In our second anchor scripture, the Bible reveals that the secret things belong to the Lord but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do them. When God shows you the secrets for enlargement, that is

revelation given to you. These secrets can be found in His Word and when you live by them, you shall be enlarged.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus we pray that you reveal to us the secrets for our enlargement. Father, we pray for the staying power to know the secrets of our enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ENLARGEMENT BY OVERCOMING COMPLACENCY

Joshua 7:2 And Joshua sent men from Jericho to Ai, which is beside Bethaven, on the east side of Bethel, and spake unto them, saying, Go up and view the country. And the men went up and viewed Ai.

3 And they returned to Joshua, and said unto him, Let not all the people go up; but let about two or three thousand men go up and smite Ai; and make not all the people to labour thither; for they are but few. 4 So there went up thither of the people about three thousand men: and they fled before the men of Ai.

5 And the men of Ai smote of them about thirty and six men: for they chased them from before the gate even unto Shebarim, and smote them in the going down: wherefore the hearts of the people melted, and became as water.

Philippians 3: 14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

In the pursuit of enlargement, you must be angry at your current level before you can contend for enlargement. There is a thin line between complacency and contentment. In complacency you plateau at a level with no passion or desire to move forward especially after achieving great feats. Contentment is being

grateful to God for where He has brought you and celebrating and enjoying every small victory as though that is all there is. So, in enlargement you must be content in how God is enlarging you step by step. But do not be complacent that you have arrived. There are many more territories to cover.

In our first anchor scripture, Joshua was complacent and took part of the army for the war but they were defeated. Hardly, did he know that someone had committed a sin within the camp. You must not be complacent in your pursuit of enlargement. You must deal with both internal and external hindrances squarely on all fronts.

In conclusion, we should be like Apostle Paul in our second anchor scripture who continued to press towards the mark for the prize of the higher calling in Christ. Your boundary for enlargement is determined by Christ and as such you must continue to press till you reach that mark.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus, we thank you for enlarging us each day. We are very satisfied and content with every level you take us to. Father in the name of Jesus we pray that you help us to quickly forget the feeling of yesterday's victory and move on to tomorrow's enlargement. We pray for the grace to push for our enlargement and not become complacent in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ENLARGEMENT BY DIVINE DIRECTION (PART 1)

Psalms 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.

3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

God is a God of enlargement. God's power follows where He leads his children. In the enlargement equation you must be led by God. All the Patriarchs experienced enlargement because they followed divine direction. Your greener pasture (your place of enlargement) is determined by divine direction. In our first anchor scripture, the psalmist revealed how God was his shepherd and that He led him to still waters and greener pastures. Jesus said He is the good shepherd and as such if we can follow His direction, He will lead us to our place of enlargement.

In our second anchor scripture, apostle Paul revealed that as many as are led by the Holy Spirit, they are the mature sons of God. Mature sons of God walk in the supernatural and as such they can be easily enlarged supernaturally.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus we pray that you lead us in the way we should go for our enlargement. We pray that we will not be misled by our flesh. We pray that we will be redirected from any path outside your will. We pray that we will dwell on the path for our enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

1 YEAR BIBLE READING PLAN: 2 Kings 12-13, 2 Chronicles 24

ENLARGEMENT BY DIVINE DIRECTION (PART 2).

John 2:1 And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there: 2 And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage. 3 And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine. 4 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? mine hour is not yet come. 5 His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.

6 And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece. 7 Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim. 8 And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it. 9 When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom, 10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.

Divine direction will lead you to your place of enlargement. In our anchor scripture, our master Jesus at the marriage of Canaan

gave them a directive to fill the pots with water and there was a testimony of enlargement. Thus, the water was changed to wine to serve many people. When you are enlarged, your results benefit others.

It is important to note that, the servants had to believe the words of Jesus and perform it to see the results. In following divine direction, you must have faith in the giver of the direction. Your confidence should be in God who knows the end from the beginning and the beginning from the end. You must trust His leadings even when it doesn't make logical sense. At the end, His glory will manifest and there shall be a testimony of enlargement.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus we pray that you lead us in the way we should go for our enlargement. We pray that we will be able to hear the Lord's voice for divine direction for our enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ENLARGEMENT BY APPRECIATING SMALL VICTORIES

1Thessalonians 5:18 In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

Hebrews 13:15 By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.

God's desire is for us to enlarge. However, He does it one step at a time. Thus, a steady but sure process into our place of enlargement. So, you must learn to thank him every day for His plan for your enlargement each day and do what is necessary for that enlargement to manifest. Thanksgiving is an act of faith and a multiplier of the things God gives. A multiplier is an enlargement factor.

Inevitably, in our first anchor scripture, Apostle Paul admonishes us to give thanks to God in all things. Every small victory must be appreciated with all of our heart. On the other hand, our hearts must long for what God is about to do next.

Let us continue to offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name in every step of the way to our place of enlargement.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus we thank you for gradually leading us into heights of enlargement. As we give thanks, may the Lord multiply our efforts for enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ENLARGEMENT BY CONSISTENCY. PART ONE

1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

Colossians 4:2 Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;

In the program of enlargement, you must be disciplined to be consistent. There are many things the Bible tells us to be consistent in. For instance: consistency in prayer, fasting, giving, working for God, etc. It is the consistency that brings the enlargement we desire. God respects people who are consistent. It is more important to fight to be consistent than to do a hit and run (once in a while).

In our first anchor scripture, Apostle Paul revealed that our labour is not in vain and as such we must be steadfast, unmoveable and always abounding in the work of the Lord. To be steadfast, unmoveable and always abounding speaks of consistency. If we are consistent, our labour will not be in vain.

On another note, prayer brings enlargement and in our second anchor scripture, Apostle Paul admonishes us to continue in prayer. If you desire to enlarge you must be consistent in prayer.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus we pray for the Spirit of consistency. Father, help us to remain consistent. We pray for angelic assistance to become consistent. We pray for associations and atmospheres that inspire us to be consistent. Father, we pray that you help us to bear the fruit of self-control in all things in Jesus' name. Amen.*

ENLARGEMENT BY CONSISTENCY. PART TWO

Proverbs 14:23 In all labour there is profit: but the talk of the lips tendeth only to penury.

Hebrews 10:35 Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. 36 For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

God is a God of enlargement. It is God's desire for us to be enlarged. However, there is a part for us to play in this journey of faith. In our first anchor scripture, King Solomon advised us that in all labour there is profit. If we desire for enlargement, we must continue to labour daily without giving up. Consistent results (enlargement) require consistent inputs.

In our second anchor scripture, the writer of Hebrews talks about doing the will of God. We must not give up but remain confident and consistent in our pursuit. Surely, after we have done the will of God, there will be a manifestation of the things we desire. Consistency in each day will prepare you for your season of appearing (Kairos moments) which may occur few times in your

lifetime. If you do not want to miss your season of gross enlargement then you must be consistent in the daily victories of small enlargements.

In conclusion, consistency will bring enlargement. Never give up but continue in faith.

In conclusion, our second anchor scripture reveals that we can enter into a covenant with God through sacrifice. God's covenant with men is His commitment to bring us into our place of enlargement.

PRAYER: *Father, we pray that you grant us the power to sacrifice for our enlargement. Father, point out the things we need to sacrifice to enter into our place of enlargement. Father, we pray that any seed we have sacrificed may it begin to speak on our behalf for enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

In our second anchor scripture, Apostle Paul prayed that the eyes of their understanding be enlightened. When our eyes are enlightened and we receive the spirit of revelation, we will gain access to the light needed for our enlargement.

the Scriptures. It is not every strategy for enlargement that is biblical. Some strategies may look good but worldly. We are not of this world and as such our strategies must be heavenly inspired. Worldly strategies of enlargement do not give divine enlargement.

Let us submit to the Word of God and take up divine strategies for our enlargement.

And Jacob said, Thou shalt not give me any thing: if thou wilt do this thing for me, I will again feed and keep thy flock: 32 I will pass through all thy flock to day, removing from thence all the speckled and spotted cattle, and all the brown cattle among the sheep, and the spotted and speckled among the goats: and of such shall be my hire.....38 And he set the rods which he had pilled before the flocks in the gutters in the watering troughs when the flocks came to drink, that they should conceive when they came to drink. 39 And the flocks conceived before the rods, and brought forth cattle ringstraked, speckled, and spotted....41 And it came to pass, whensoever the stronger cattle did conceive, that Jacob laid the rods before the eyes of the cattle in the gutters, that they might conceive among the rods. 42 But when the cattle were feeble, he put them not in: so the feebler were Laban's, and the stronger Jacob's. 43 And the man increased exceedingly, and had much cattle, and maidservants, and menservants, and camels, and asses.

The use of divine strategies and tactics in the pursuit of enlargement is very crucial. This inspired strategy or tactic is a system of advantage for the Christian. In our anchor scripture, we observe how a divine strategy from the Lord helped Jacob to increase in cattle (to be enlarged). After Laban had cheated Jacob several times, God gave Jacob a divine strategy that was used to help him recover his wages. The strategy of Jacob logically did not make sense and that was why Laban quickly jumped at the offer Jacob gave. However, the strategy was God's system of advantage for Jacob. It worked out perfectly and he was enlarged.

In conclusion, let us trust the Lord for divine strategies and tactics that will propel us in life and destiny.

In our third anchor scripture, we observe that God is the one that gives us the power to get wealth (financial enlargement). If God is able to give us the ability for financial enlargement, then He is able to give us the ability for enlargement in all things. The New Testament reveals that the Holy Spirit as the custodian of God's power dwells in us. We can tap into that power to enter into our place of enlargement. We have God's ability in us for all things and it is our duty to convert this available power or ability to effectual power or ability for use in our daily lives.

God's power is available for you in your pursuit of enlargement. Tap into that power to be enlarged.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus, you said you are able to do whatever we ask or think according to the power at work in us. We ask for enlargement in every area of our lives. We receive the power for our enlargement. I declare that it is God that gives me the power to get wealth. I pray for this power to experience financial enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

God is a God of enlargement and He desires that His children be enlarged. To a large extent, prosperity is one of the obvious proofs of enlargement. In our anchor scripture, we observe that the office of the Prophet is endowed with the grace to cause God's children to prosper (to be enlarged).

For instance; God brought Israel out of Egypt by Prophet Moses. They left with full financial enlargement. Elisha the Prophet declared abundance of food in a time of famine for the city of Samaria. All these situations point to a testimony of enlargement.

Inevitably, prophetic encounters in this study speaks of encounters with the office of the Prophet. When your season of enlargement is due, God will send a prophet to usher you to that realm. You must be able to discern and receive that servant of God. Typically, your shepherd (Pastor) is your default prophet for life and it is important to honour and receive his or her prophetic words of enlargement in your life. In addition, God can also send other ministry gifts (Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Teachers) operating in the prophetic at a given point in time to bring you words of enlargement.

In conclusion, honour all servants of God for they speak for our peace and enlargement as ordained by God.

PRAYER: *Father, we pray that through prophetic encounters with your servants, we may be able to enter into our place of enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

Prophetic encounters in this context are supernatural encounters with God, angels and the spirit of just men made perfect. A pivotal point for enlargement in our walk with God is usually preceded by a prophetic encounter.

In conclusion, prophetic encounters are important in ushering us to our place of enlargement. You must desire for these encounters and learn to discern them when they come.

PRAYER: *Father, we pray that through prophetic encounters with you, your angels and the spirit of just men made perfect we may be able to enter into our place of enlargement in Jesus' name. Amen.*

In conclusion, follow people with visible signs of enlargement and learn from them to the end that you will also be enlarged.

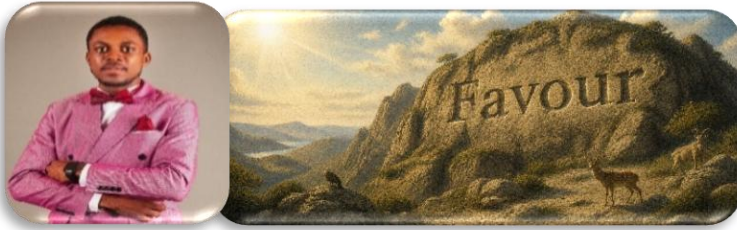
God is a God of enlargement and He desires that His children be enlarged. It is important to note that enlargement in life and destiny also speaks of advancement in life. When God elevates

Then I was very sore afraid, 3 And said unto the king, Let the king live for ever: why should not my countenance be sad, when the city, the place of my fathers' sepulchres, lieth waste, and the gates thereof are consumed with fire? 4 Then the king said unto me, For what dost thou make request? So I prayed to the God of heaven. 5 And I said unto the king, If it please the king, and if thy servant have found favour in thy sight, that thou wouldest send me unto Judah, unto the city of my fathers' sepulchres, that I may build it. 6 And the king said unto

me, (the queen also sitting by him,) For how long shall thy journey be? and when wilt thou return? So it pleased the king to send me; and I set him a time. 7 Moreover I said unto the king, If it please the king, let letters be given me to the governors beyond the river, that they may convey me over till I come into Judah; 8 And a letter unto Asaph the keeper of the king's forest, that he may give me timber to make beams for the gates of the palace which appertained to the house, and for the wall of the city, and for the house that I shall enter into. And the king granted me, according to the good hand of my God upon me. 9 Then I came to the governors beyond the river, and gave them the king's letters. Now the king had sent captains of the army and horsemen with me.

The biblical passage for today's study reveals a very radical manifestation of God's favour and as such it is worth quoting as the background for the study. In our first anchor scripture, Nehemiah prayed to God for favour in the sight of the king and in our second anchor scripture, Nehemiah received the answer to his prayer. The king favoured him greatly and granted him all his request. In favour we receive great help in whatever we are doing. The help we get because of favour can usher us to our place of enlargement.

In conclusion, favour is the main reason why men are helped to advance in life and destiny.

PRAYER: *Father, we thank you for your Word today. We pray for the grace of favour to cause us to enlarge in Jesus' name. Amen.*

against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

God is a God of enlargement and He desires that His children be enlarged. In the Old Testament, the people of Israel had to fight to enlarge their coast. In our anchor scripture, we observe one of such battles over the territory. The children of Ammon, Moab and mount Seir were gathered against the children of Israel (God's people). The battle strategy that was used was praise. When we praise God in the face of a fierce battle for our enlargement, we turn over the battle to God. In this story, the Lord set ambushes against the enemies of Israel and they were smitten.

In conclusion, it is important to note that everyone can praise the Lord. There is no excuse as long as you are alive on earth (***Psalms 150:6 Let everything that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.***).

PRAYER: Father, we thank you for your Word today. We thank you for teaching us on the power of praise. I pray and yield myself as a vessel of continuous praise to you in Jesus' name. Amen.

16 And as the ark of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window, and saw king David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her heart.

17 And they brought in the ark of the LORD, and set it in his place, in the midst of the tabernacle that David had pitched for it: and David offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the LORD.

18 And as soon as David had made an end of offering burnt offerings and peace offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD of hosts.

God is a God of enlargement and He desires that His children be enlarged. In our anchor scripture, we see another testimony of advancement in the life of king David. He was restoring the ark of the covenant to its place and he danced before the Lord with all his might. Dancing is one simple and sure way of celebrating

our God. We dance before the Lord with great joy and reverence in honour of the victory (enlargement) He has given us.

A man who knows how to dance before the Lord with joy and reverence to Him is a man who understands that God is the source of all the good things he or she is enjoying. In this regard, God continues to enlarge that person from one level to another. Dancing before the Lord is a secret for people who desire to enter into their place of enlargement. It is important to note that we are not talking about dancing only in church although it forms a significant part of the discussion, but I am largely highlighting our personal dancing and celebrating the Lord in our closet.

David was a lover of God and he danced before the Lord. As lovers of God, let us rejoice in the presence of God and there are doors of enlargement we will not need to ask but He will open them for us.

So the men sat down, in number about five thousand. 11 And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would. 12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost. 13 Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten. 14 Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

God is a God of enlargement and He desires that His children be enlarged. In our anchor scripture, we observe that thanksgiving was the key Jesus used to multiply the two fishes and the five loaves of bread. Thanking God is important in our pursuit of enlargement. When you give thanks, you express your profound gratitude and that is why it is important to be thoughtful about what God has done in your thanksgiving and then take time to itemize them and pour your heart to the Lord. You may not even need to ask God for enlargement but God will continue to enlarge and advance you if you live a life of thanksgiving.

In conclusion, we must thank God in all things for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus (1 Thessalonians 5:18). A life of thanksgiving is a peaceful life with a perpetual enlargement and advancement in all things.
