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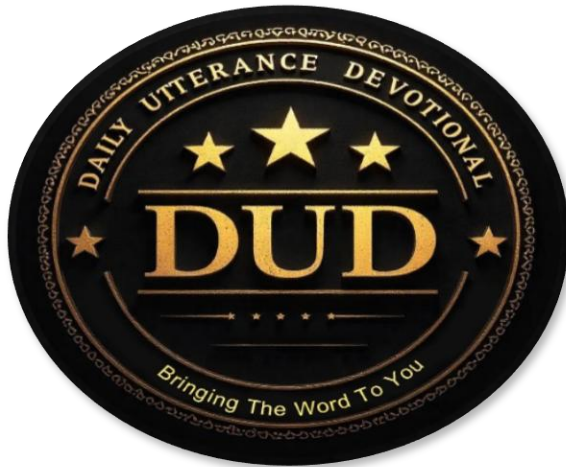

ORDAINED UNTO GOOD WORKS

Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

In our anchor scripture, Apostle Paul reveals that we are the master piece (workmanship) of God created in Christ. This means that good works according Paul are recognizable by God only in Christ. You have to be a Christian to work good works. You must understand that if an unbeliever does good things, they are not necessarily considered as good works but they are considered as dead works. This is because anyone who is not born again is dead in trespasses and sins (*Ephesians 2:1-And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins*). You must understand that it is not about whether what the person did was right or wrong but who he or she is. Dead people automatically do dead works. Thus, who you are determines the type of work you do. Unbelievers are dead so they do dead work. Christians

are born again and alive in Christ so the works they do are living and good.

Again, we have been created in Christ Jesus unto good works. There are many good works that we are called to do. It is our duty to identify them and do them. Discovery of these good works is important if you want to fulfil your divine purpose on earth.

Apostle Paul highlighted that the good work (divine purpose) has already been ordained. Your destiny is already written. You must find your path (your story) in God's story and live to fulfil that purpose. Live a life of purpose if you want to live a fulfilled life. There is a reason for your existence on earth. Find that assignment and live up to that expectation. God is counting on you.

The Prayer of Alignment

Jeremiah 33:3 Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.

Luke 22:42 Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.

We are to fulfil our divine purpose on earth. However, the discovery of the assignment is part of the assignment. In the context of this series, the following labels are used interchangeably; divine purpose, divine assignment, fulfilling destiny. These three terms/labels are used to describe the reason why God brought you to the earth (the purpose of your creation).

You can discover your divine purpose through prayer. There are two types of prayer you can make when it comes to your divine purpose. You can do the prayer of enquiry or a prayer of alignment. In the former you ask God to show you His purpose/will for your life whilst in the latter you pray to conform

to that will by yielding up your will in prayer (thus, you align to God's will).

In our first anchor scripture, prophet Jeremiah assures us that when we call upon the Lord, He will hear us. In our second anchor scripture, our Lord and master Jesus knew in prayer what the will of God was for His life and as such He prayed that the will of God be done. You must pray to submit and align your will to the will of God. Prayer of alignment is simply praying that God uses you for His purpose or will.

In conclusion, spend quality time to pray about your divine assignment. Its fulfilment is a life well lived.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus, we thank you for practically teaching us your Word. Father, show me your will for my life in Christ Jesus. Father, I yield to your will for my life in Christ Jesus. Let your will be done in Jesus' name. Amen.*

Php 2:13 For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.

John 4:34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.

We must fight to fulfil destiny. Discovery of the assignment is part of the assignment. Another key to discover your purpose is to study where your inner passions points to. When you have a

holy passion for a certain purpose, it is a sign that it can be your divine purpose. Jesus had serious passion for the house of God. In our first anchor scripture, He scourged the people who were selling in the house of God. His divine assignment made Him passionate about God's house.

In our second anchor scripture, Jesus was passionately talking to the Samaritan woman to the extent that He could ignore His necessary food. Fulfilling His divine purpose brought Him more satisfaction than His necessary food.

In our third anchor scripture, apostle Paul highlights that this strong desire to do the will God is a stirring by God Himself. The Spirit of God stirs up a holy passion for the will and purpose of God. If you carefully consider these inner stirrings and passion, you can easily discover your divine purpose.

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus, we thank you for your Word today. Father, stir in me a holy passion for my divine assignment. Father, let this holy passion push me to pay any price necessary for the manifestation of my divine assignment in Jesus' name. Amen.*

We must fight to fulfil our divine assignment. Discovery of the assignment is part of the assignment. Another key strategy to discover your purpose is through the prophetic ministry. The Lord speaks through His prophets to us. When we keep a good journal of our prophecies, it can really guide us to discover our divine assignment.

In our anchor scripture, apostle Paul admonished Timothy to war a good warfare by the prophecies he has received. The next verse shows him how to wage that war. Thus, holding faith and a good conscience. Remember that faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. So, as you receive prophecies, that is the word of God coming to you. If you want to war a good warfare by the prophecies then those prophecies you receive must be alive

in your spirit. You keep the word afresh through meditation and this will cause you to keep your faith and fight till you fulfil your divine assignment. Never despise prophecies about your divine purpose, they will guide you to discover the reason why God brought you to the earth.

Discovery through Prophecies 2

1 Timothy 1:18 This charge I commit unto thee, son Timothy, according to the prophecies which went before on thee, that thou by them mightest war a good warfare; 19 Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning faith have made shipwreck:

We must fight to fulfil our divine assignment. Discovery of the assignment is part of the assignment. As a Pastor, I have witnessed people getting confused with prophecies about their divine assignment. It is important to note that prophecies about our divine purpose are not contradictory or confusing but just as Paul said we prophecy in part, prophecies about our divine purpose are given in parts. For instance; if a prophet was to prophesy about Jesus' ministry and saw only his healing ministry, that does not mean that another prophet who sees only his death is wrong. Altogether, your divine assignment is multifaceted so it is important to document every piece of information you receive from any prophet then by engaging the Holy Spirit you can add

the pieces together to know which prophecy is for which time and which prophecy is an auxiliary part of your destiny.

On another note, there are depths in the prophetic ministry and as such it is important to judge prophecies with the Word of God and also according to the spiritual rank of the Prophet.

In conclusion, prophecies are very useful in discovering our divine assignment so we must receive them in good faith and work towards them in order to fulfil our divine assignment.

Discovery through personal revelation

Genesis 37:5 And Joseph dreamed a dream, and he told it his brethren: and they hated him yet the more. 6 And he said unto them, Hear, I pray you, this dream which I have dreamed: 7 For, behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright; and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf. 8 And his brethren said to him, Shalt thou indeed reign over us? or shalt thou indeed have dominion over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words. 9 And he dreamed yet another dream, and told it his brethren, and said, Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me....11 And his brethren envied him; but his father observed the saying.

Acts 9: 3 And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven: 4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? 5 And he

said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks. 6 And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do..

We must fight to fulfil destiny. Discovery of the assignment is part of the assignment. Another key for discovering your divine purpose is through personal revelation. In our first anchor scripture, Joseph had a dream about his divine purpose. In our second anchor scripture, Paul had a personal encounter with Jesus in an open vision and his purpose was revealed to him.

The Lord can reveal our divine purpose to us in a personal way. This personal revelation of your divine purpose may come through a dream like Joseph or an open vision like Paul. Inevitably, the end of these encounters is a personal revelation of your divine purpose. You may receive this personal revelation in your infancy or in adulthood. Convincingly, personal revelations are useful in discovering your divine assignment.

PRAYER: *Father, I thank you for your Word today. Father, I pray that you show me the blueprint for my life and destiny. Father, grant me clarity of purpose. Guide me to fulfil exactly what you made me for in Jesus' name. Amen.*

Discovery through Following

Hebrews 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

We must fight to fulfil destiny. Discovery of the assignment is part of the assignment. Another key for discovering your purpose is through following. The disciples followed Jesus and they discovered their divine assignment. Elisha followed Elijah whilst Joshua followed Moses. In fact, our making is by following.

In our first anchor scripture Jesus told Peter and the others to follow him and he will make them fishers of men. As you follow someone who has discovered his or her divine purpose you will inevitably find yours too. It takes the led to lead others.

In our second anchor scripture, the writer of Hebrews reveals that following is a diligent work. We should not be slothful but

diligent followers of those who are in the right path pursuing their purpose. They can help us to discover our own purpose. There are countries who begun producing things by copying others but now they are able to produce unique products by themselves. There is nothing wrong with following. Follow until you become what you are called to be. Never stop following. God will help you to find your own path.

PRAYER: *Father we thank you for your Word today. Father, I pray that you help me to identify those I must follow in order to fulfil destiny. Father, make me a diligent follower of those I must follow to become who you have called me to be in Jesus' name. Amen.*

Luke 14:28 For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it? 29 Lest haply, after he hath laid the foundation, and is not able to finish it, all that behold it begin to mock him, 30 Saying, This man began to build, and was not able to finish. 31 Or what king, going to make war against another king, sitteth not down first, and consulteth whether he be able with ten thousand to meet him that cometh against him with twenty thousand? 32 Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sendeth an ambassage, and desireth conditions of peace. 33 So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.

We must fight to fulfil our destiny. After discovery of your divine assignment, you must decide to fulfil that divine assignment. Your satisfaction in life is based on that one decision you must make. Your decisions can make or unmake you.

In our anchor scripture, Jesus used two scenarios to teach that we must count the cost of each decision before we take it. Since the fulfilment of your divine assignment will bring glory to God, know for sure that there will be an opposition from the kingdom of darkness to frustrate you from fulfilling that purpose.

On another note, the fulfilment of every divine assignment comes with a price tag. There is a price to pay in actualizing that purpose. Jesus had to endure the cross to attain the glory. In fulfilling your divine assignment, you must go through the cross before you see the glory. A good decision to fulfil your divine assignment will guide you to anticipate all these costs/risks which will help you to prepare your heart and mind for the journey ahead.

In conclusion, decide today that you want to fulfil your divine assignment and become resolute in your convictions. The Lord shall help you to fulfil that divine purpose.

assignment. We pray to break evil forces and resistance that attempt to prevent or restrain us from fulfilling our divine purpose. As already indicated in our previous study, the fulfilment of our divine assignment will bring glory to God and that is a big blow to Satan and his cohorts. Consequently, they have an unflinching desire to frustrate and prevent Christians from fulfilling their purpose. We must fight on all fronts to resist the gates of hell and fulfil our divine assignment to the end that God will be glorified.

In conclusion, prayer is a sure way of calling for divine assistance. We cannot fulfil our divine assignment with our own strength, we need the help of God to achieve it. Prayer is the basic way for calling for divine help and consequently, prayer is a major foundation for the fulfilment of our divine purpose.

38 Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me. 39 And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.

We must fight to fulfil our divine assignment. There are key things to consider if you really want to fulfil your divine assignment. Another foundation for fulfilling your divine assignment is total surrender. In total surrender you can say Lord use me as you will. In total surrender you give up your will to God. The will of God swallows up your will. Your divine purpose is God's will for your life. Your divine purpose comes with a price tag so if your will is not swallowed up by the will of God, you cannot fulfil your divine assignment. Jesus had to give up His will

in order to fulfil His divine assignment (the will of the Father). Total surrender is what will cause you to freely give up your will and take up your cross (your divine assignment and the price you must pay).

It is important to note that we are both sons and servants of God. The fulfilment of our divine assignment reflects our servanthood. Total surrender is the ultimate key of being a servant of Christ. Thus, in total surrender, Jesus is your Lord and you are His servant. As a servant, your sole responsibility is to please your master (***2 Timothy 2:3 Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. 4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier***).

PRAYER: *Father, I pray to yield my will to you. Father, I surrender all to you. Use me for your will in Jesus' name. Amen.*

The end of your obedience to God is the manifestation of the glory of God (*Exodus 40:33 And he reared up the court round about the tabernacle and the altar, and set up the hanging of the court gate. So Moses finished the work. 34 Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle*).

In conclusion, obedience is better than sacrifice. Learn to follow the will of God fully in the pursuit of destiny. At the end, you shall see the glory of God manifest.

You must learn and become a master in your industry. Be an ardent reader and a continuous learner. Your destiny shall surely manifest.

God can touch the hearts of men to help you fulfil destiny. Some types of men God can bring your way to help you fulfil your divine assignment may include;

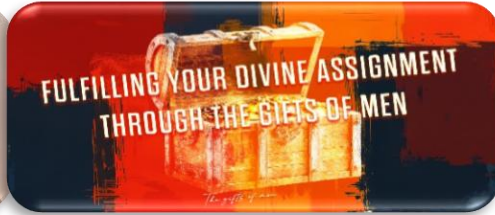
1. Burden bearers: people who help you to carry the cross (the burden of your divine assignment). They are vision builders.

In our second anchor scripture, the writer of Hebrews simply tells us that the less is blessed by the greater and this implies that the grace we do not honour we cannot contact. We must be humble to receive from others.

In conclusion, we need more grace in order to fulfil our divine assignment and as such we must strive to grow in grace.

In our second anchor scripture, Jesus told them if they follow Him, they will become fishers of men. Thus, they will fulfil their

divine assignment. It is easier to discover and fulfil your divine assignment if you submit yourself under mentorship.

Discerning and Receiving God's Help

Hebrews 13:2 Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

In our previous study, we understood that it is important for us to receive the help of God in order to fulfil our divine assignment. However, the way and manner in which God sends help to men requires discernment.

In Abraham's encounter with the Lord and the two angels in Genesis 18, Abraham had to discern that they were not humans but it was a heavenly visitation.

We must be able to discern and receive God's help in whatever form that He sends it. God's help will enable us to fulfil our divine assignment.
