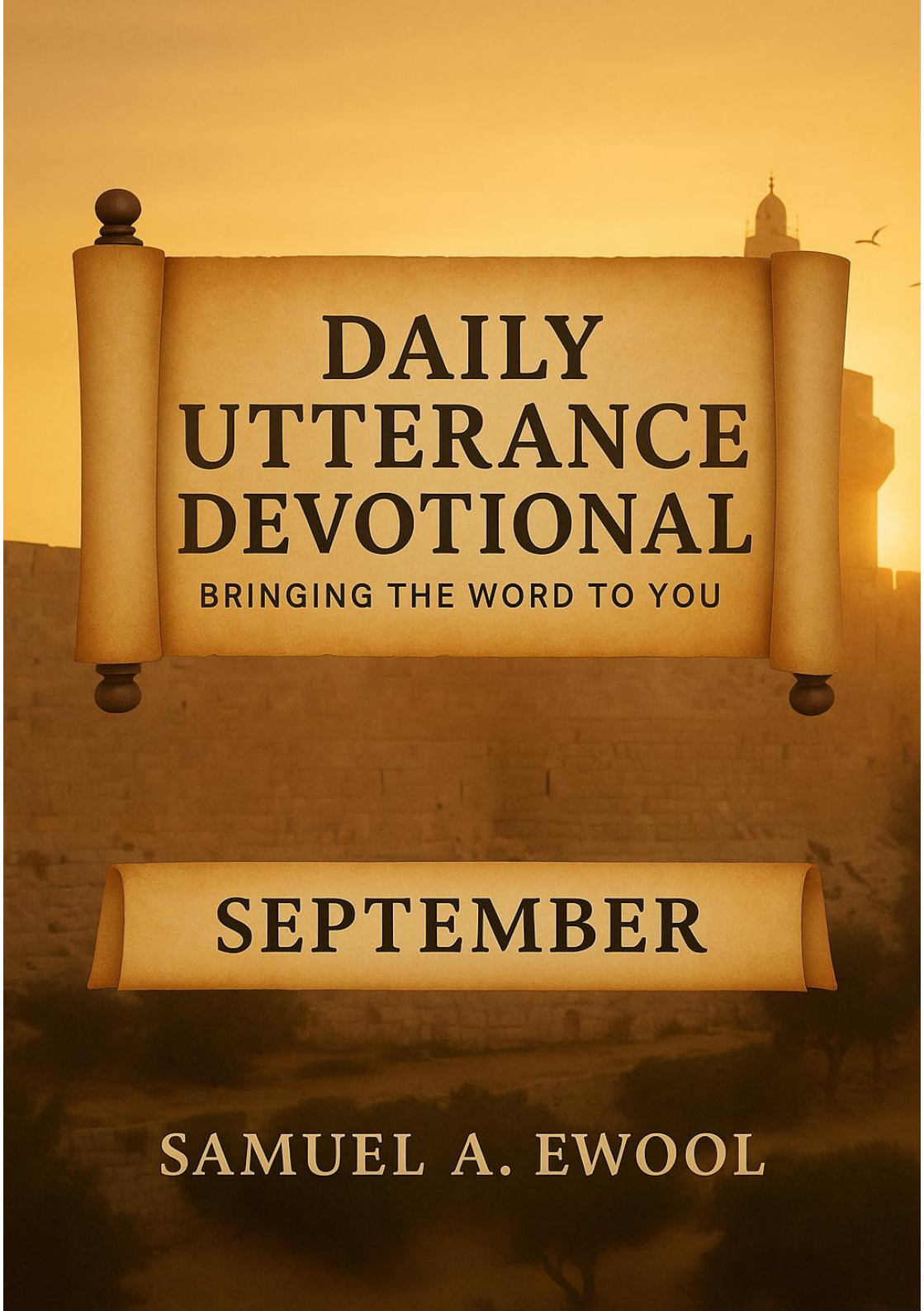

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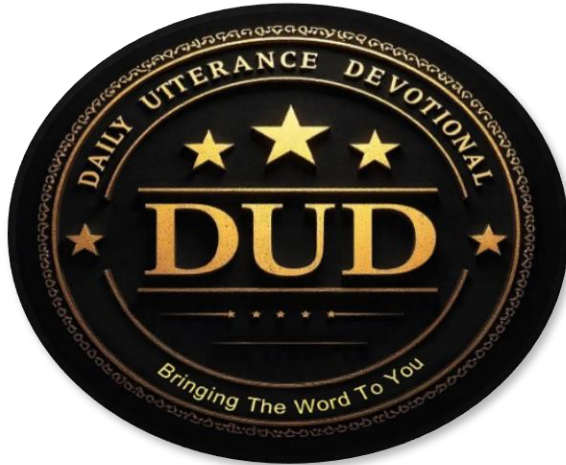
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INTRODUCTION

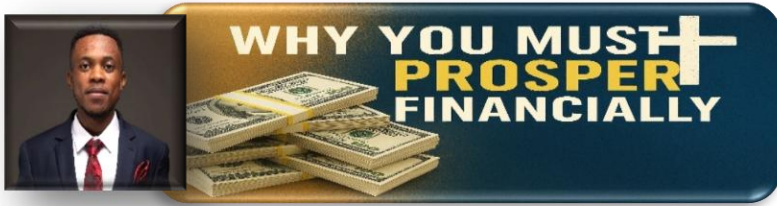
Tips on How to Effectively Use the Devotional

WHY YOU MUST PROSPER FINANCIALLY

The subject of prosperity sometimes causes a stir among Christians. There are some who argue that it is not important whilst others over emphasize its importance. However, in this study we are going to consider three basic reasons why a Christian must prosper financially. Knowing why things are done is very important because God looks at the inward (motives of the heart). The reason why we are doing something is very important to God. Some godly reasons why must prosper financially include the following;

1. It is God's will for us to prosper. When we are born again, we are born to prosper. It is in our nature to prosper. It is our heritage in Christ. God desires prosperity for all His children (1 John 3:1).
2. Financial prosperity gives a Christian a sound atmosphere (an atmosphere void of the effects of poverty on a man) to serve God better. Imagine a Christian at the peak of deep worship who gets distracted by a knock on his door just because his land lord is coming for his rent. Financial prosperity can simply prevent this from happening. Remember that Solomon

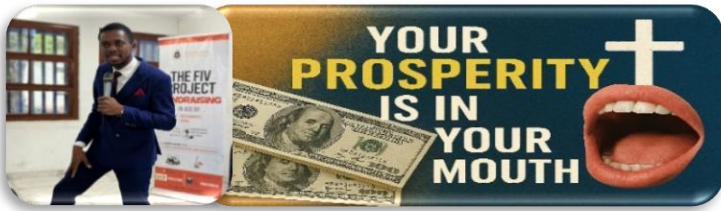
said money is a defense (Ecc. 7:12). It can shield you from some physical issues of life.

3. Financial prosperity is important for kingdom advancement: There is a lot the Church will not achieve if we are not financially sound. Again, recalling the words of Solomon that money is a defense (Ecc. 7:12), it means money can be used as a weapon of war. The battle for souls is not only going to be won on our knees (prayer) but also through our pockets (financial prosperity).

In conclusion, with the right motive for prosperity, the Lord will lavishly pour out His riches to His children for the silver and gold are mine says the Lord (Haggai 2:8).

Joshua 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

In our anchor scripture, we see one important key for our financial prosperity which is our mouths. Our mouths have been given to us as the weapon for our financial prosperity. When recall our study on meditation, we studied that the highest point of meditation is prayerfully speaking and repeating the Word of God. This is how you are going to shape your life by your words. Thus, as you meditate on the Word of God, you are filled with that same Word which will cause you to speak rightly about the situations of life (faith filled words). This is how we make our way prosperous. Our meditation of the word principally feeds us with the word of God whilst our faith-filled speakings (confessions) in situations of life shapes our world. What you speak is what you get. It is important therefore to speak what God has spoken and that is proper biblical confession.

So, for instance; after meditating (feeding) on the Word of God concerning your prosperity in Christ, you will begin to speaking rightly (exercising yourself in the Word) and that is how you will make your way prosperous in terms of your finances.

In conclusion, our mouths were not given to us just to eat food or to talk about people but it was primarily given to us to function like God (speak realities into being) for man was created in God's image and likeness.

YOU ARE BORN TO PROSPER

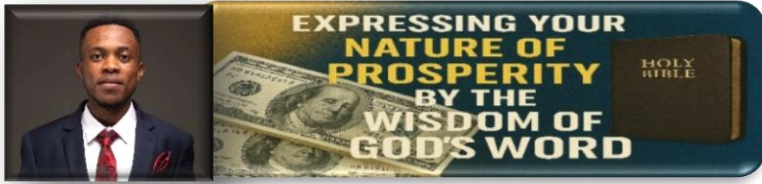

It is our heritage in Christ. However, that nature of prosperity can be given much expression in our lives as we grow in Christ. Let me illustrate this with a scenario; A female baby has every potential in her nature to reproduce but at the age of one she cannot give birth to another baby. She must grow to an adult to be able to express that nature. Same way, you have the nature of prosperity in your spirit and you must grow in Christ to express it fully. The Christian has in his/her nature all what it takes to live rich but this

is proportional to the level of your growth in Christ. Remember that, there are various aspects of our Christian life and you must strive to grow holistically in every aspect of your life. In growing in prosperity, you must look out for what the word talks about our prosperity in Christ. You must understand that our growth in Christ is knowledge dependent. Go for the word on prosperity and begin to practice what it teaches and you will begin to see a perpetual and lasting growth in prosperity. Our life in Christ is from glory to glory. Hallelujah!!!

EXPRESSING YOUR NATURE OF PROSPERITY BY THE WISDOM OF GOD'S WORD

In our previous study, we understood that we have been born with the nature of prosperity in Christ. We are born to prosper. It is important therefore to know some practical ways of expressing this nature of prosperity in our daily walk on earth. Thus, the following practical principles are ways of demonstrating our faith in Christ in terms of prosperity. If you believe you are born to prosper, you can easily engage in the wisdom the word of God teaches about our prosperity. Some practical keys include;

a. *First fruits and tithes:* Because of the controversies about these two principles, we will deal with them in a separate teaching. But for now, I would say that they are not principles that have being abolished because they pre-date the law.

b. *Freewill offering:* This is what we normally take to church on Sundays. You are to give according to how much riches/wealth God has entrusted you with. In fact, decide what you would give a day before service, pray over it and give cheerfully.

c. *The concept of sowing and reaping:* Thus, you must engage seed time and Harvest. Some practical wisdom in using this key;

- Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord: You must give to the servants of God (especially your man of God). Two scripture references (*Psalms 118:27 God is the LORD, And He has given us light; Bind the sacrifice with cords to the horns of the altar. Matthew 10:41 He that receiveth a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward; and he that receiveth a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward*).
- Give to both your spiritual and biological parents: *Eph 6:2 Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;)* *3 That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.*
- Give to all men. Be generous across board. *Proverbs 11:24 There is that scattereth, and yet increaseth; and there is that withholdeth more than is meet, but it tendeth to poverty.*

d. Biblical Saving: You save for the future so that when God needs you to give you can have something to give (*Proverbs 21:20 There is a store of great value in the house of the wise, but it is wasted by the foolish man- BBE*).

PRAYER: *Father in the name of Jesus, we pray that we will continue to walk in the wisdom and principles for expressing the nature of prosperity daily in Jesus' name. Amen.*

GIVING THANKS YIELDS SUFFICIENCY

John 6:10 And Jesus said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand. 11 And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would. 12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost. 13 Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.

In our anchor scripture, we see Jesus performing a miracle by giving thanks to God. When what you have is not sufficient, you do not have to complain but you can learn from the master Jesus to give thanks to God for providing what you have. Sometimes, some Christians often forget to see the hand of God in the little and as such they do not see the hand of God in the much. Usually, the first that God gives is like a test. It is not the actual blessing He wants to give you but sometimes we are given the little to reveal the state of our heart. As Jesus clearly puts it in ***Luke 16:10 He that is faithful in that which is least***

is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. Jesus did not say he that is faithful in little ***will be*** faithful in much but he used the present tense that ***he is*** faithful. What you do with the little God provides reveals who you are.

In conclusion, learn to give thanks in the little God gives you and see how He will supernaturally multiply the little into much to the end that you have sufficiency in all things. Glory!!!

Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Our salvation and its benefits span from our nature, life and in fact everything about us and as such whatever life we want to enjoy has been freely given to us (2 Peter 1:3). Principally, our work in the New Testament is to grow to manifest who we are (the finished works of Christ). God has called us unto good works. Discovering the assignment is part of fulfilling the assignment. As we walk with the Holy Spirit, He searches the deep things of God and reveals to us the good works that God has ordained for us that we should walk in them. YOUR PERSONAL EDIFICATION AS A CHRISTIAN

1Peter 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:

If you are born again, then you must grow again. Our anchor scripture instructs us to go for the Word of God to grow. However, we are not just expected to grow by increasing in size but we are supposed to be built up (building up our form). There are practically two things needed for building up your form. Thus, eating and exercising. If you only eat without exercising you will become obese and end up being fruitless but when you eat and exercise, you build up your form. This true for the Christian.

Eating: This involves meditating on the Word of God for it to enter you and form part of you.

Exercising: This is when you practice or produce the Word of God in your everyday life. You can exercise yourself spiritually by speaking in tongues (direct spiritual substance) as in *1 Corinthians 14:4 He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church (NKJV).*

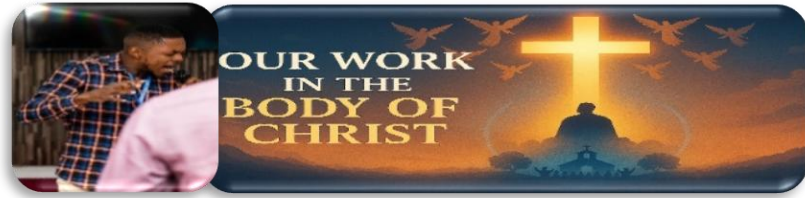
Secondly you can exercise yourself in the Spirit by praying in the Holy Ghost (*Jude 1:20 But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit*).

Thirdly, you can exercise yourself spiritually by speaking rightly in your everyday life after meditation (after the word of God has entered you). For instance: if the word of God you are eating talks about your nature it will cause you to speak rightly about who you are (this is exercising). But if it is an instruction, meditation will cause you to do what the Word is telling you. So, when you exercise yourself in the Word, it is your personal work in Christ (*James 1:25 But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does-NKJV*)

In conclusion, you must feed on the Word of God and exercise yourself spiritually to build your spiritual form which is need in fulfilling the good works God has ordained for you.

OUR WORK IN THE BODY OF CHRIST

Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

As Christians we have been called unto good works and it is our responsibility to find these works and do them in our sojourning on the earth. However, there are those whose works may be done in the body of Christ whilst others will chiefly fulfil their divine mandate in the corporate world. The works done in the body of Christ can be divided into two.

Work done directly in Church: This comprises of the use of all In-house Gifts (Romans 12:3-9), work done in the various departments of the church and any other service you render when saints meet together to worship.

Work done in the Systems or the Mountains of Influence that are purely governed by Christ and the value system of the Church: For instance, if a church establishes a TV station fully for the promotion of Christ and you work there as a journalist or a sound engineer or as an accountant, it is work directly in the body of Christ. This is because that system is directly under Christ and that is why Christians must take over the mountains of

influence to bring the systems of the world under subjection unto Christ. We must build systems and structures for the kingdom which will inevitably be a blessing to the entire body of Christ. For instance; Some Christians fear to take their children to certain schools because of the fear of their children getting polluted by worldly ideas and influences. So, imagine how it will be if Christians or churches preferably own the best schools in the world where the values of Christianity are freely taught and expressed. Christian parents will not have much to worry about. It is worthy to state here that the Christians in this context must be mature Christians because some baby Christians who own some of these systems or structures of influence do not promote the agenda of the kingdom. But if we own them, we can set the rules. Remember we are building a kingdom for Christ and not for ourselves.

In conclusion, discover the good works ordained for you in the body of Christ and fulfil them.

OUR WORK IN THE WORLD

Matthew 5:14 "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 16 "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

In our previous study we considered our work in the body of Christ but in today's study we will consider our work in the world. This primarily involves equipping the saints and sending them into the world to save men and the systems of the world (the ministry of reconciliation). Thus, we go into the world as full representatives of Christ (ambassadors) and we are to shine as light to the glory of God. Note that, you just don't wake up and go into the world but you must be equipped and sent. This is serious business and as a matter of fact, baby Christians must not be deployed for this task. Baby Christians who are sent into the world can end up being corrupted by the world. Although, they will be saved at the end of time but their works will not count in eternity because they could not reveal Christ by their works. It is worthy to state the words of Apostle Paul here ***"Eph 4:11 And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some***

evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ". The fivefold ministry is supposed to equip the saints and send them into the world for the work of the ministry.

On another note, some Christians are also sent into the world to reconcile the riches of the kingdom back to the Church for kingdom advancement. Thus, some Christians are sent into the world to fulfil their ministry of becoming kingdom financiers.

In conclusion, we have all been called and we are to be equipped for the work of the ministry.

PRAYER: *Father we thank you for your Word today. I pray and surrender all that I am to you for the purposes of the advancement of your kingdom. Lord, equip me and send me into the world to advance your kingdom by fulfilling the good works ordained for me in Christ in Jesus' name. Amen.*

THE WEAPONS OF OUR WARFARE ARE NOT CARNAL

2 Corinthians 10:4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;

Although we have physical bodies and live in a physical world, our warfare is not physical but spiritual. We don't need bombs and guns for this warfare. That is why the Bible tells us to be at peace with all men (Hebrews 12:14) because it may not be the physical person you see that is the real enemy but the forces of darkness behind the scenes. Unless the person decides by himself to become wicked and unreasonably, our warfare is not directly with humans. It is important therefore to understand that the spiritual warfare is with the devil and his cohorts. This is how Apostle Paul puts it (***Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places***). Therefore, if we are in a spiritual warfare then we must fully arm ourselves for this battle. There is a serious battle for souls and territories and we cannot afford to pretend that there is not contention against the powers of darkness in the salvation of souls and territories. Just like in any physical

battle, there are weapons, we must also arm ourselves with strategic weapons to have an assured victory. We have a greater advantage in the spirit because Jesus has given us all power and authority over the powers of darkness (***Ephesians 1:20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, 21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: 22 And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, 23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all).***)

In conclusion, our warfare is not physical but spiritual and as such we must focus more on the realm of the Spirit. Take up your spiritual weapons and establish your victory in Christ.

PRAYER: *Father we thank you for your Word today. I thank you for the understanding into spiritual warfare. I pray that I will be equipped with the right weapons through the knowledge of your Word in Jesus' name. Amen.*

YOU ARE GOD'S WEAPON FOR KINGDOM ADVANCEMENT

Jeremiah 51:20 Thou art my battle axe and weapons of war: for with thee will I break in pieces the nations, and with thee will I destroy kingdoms;

Our anchor scripture reveals how God uses men to fulfil His purposes on the earth. God has a kingdom advancement agenda which primarily is a battle for souls and territories. This implies that we must build ourselves for the warfare dimension of this advancement. I have never seen a soldier ready for war who is not fit. A good soldier engages in training and remain fit for the battle. We do not go to war with the weak and feeble. In fact, those who are afraid to lose their lives must stay home too (**Rev. 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death**). We are the church militant which must be prepared and trained in the battle to take over the kingdoms/systems of the world for Christ. It is worthy to note here that, in this kingdom, we are more than conquerors (**Rom 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us**), so we do not engage in warfare as though we are now fighting to win. Christ

has already fought for us and given us the victory. Hence, we must reign in this life through our Lord Jesus Christ. Remember that we are kings and priests so we must reign. The challenge for many Christians in reigning in this life is succinctly captured in ***Gal 4:1 Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all.*** Inevitably, our assignment as soldiers of Christ is to build ourselves and grow to the full stature of Christ. How much you have built yourself will determine how much work you can do in this kingdom (***Ephesians 4:12-13 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.***).

In conclusion, let us arise and build up ourselves for the task ahead. God is counting on us to take up territories and win many souls unto Him. Get ready!! Prepare yourself for you are God's battle axe. Hallelujah!!

THE WEAPON OF PRAYER FOR KINGDOM ADVANCEMENT

Psalms 2:8 Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

Prayer is the place for the orchestration of events, happenings and situations of life. Through prayer, a territory can bow to Christ. If our warfare is spiritual then we cannot do it without prayer. Souls and territories must first be won by prayer in the spirit before we even go there physically. In our anchor scripture, we are to ask the Lord for the expansion of our territories. This asking is done in the place of prayer. Prayer is a solid weapon for kingdom advancement.

In Philippians 4: 6, Paul admonishes us that, in everything we should involve prayer and as such the pursue of kingdom advancement cannot fall short of fervent prayers. The fervent prayer of the righteous accomplishes much so we ought to pray to win territories legally. It is worthy to state the words of Jesus

here in “***Mark 3:27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house***”. There are souls locked up in bondage under Satan and his cohorts and they can be released in the place of prayer when we bind the powers of darkness.

In conclusion, prayer must precede any kingdom agenda because without God, we can do nothing.

THE WEAPON OF INFLUENCE

There are two ways to get people to do things. It is either by force and compulsion or by influence (to have an effect on someone/something by gentle or subtle action). The devil has used subtle means to deceive the whole world and he has become the god of this world (the cosmos: the systems/mountains of influence in this world). The Church on the other hand should use gentle means to bring men into the kingdom. Being gentle does not mean you are naïve or unwise. The gentle here simply means not by subtle (trickery/crafty) means. Jesus said in ***Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.*** Thus, Christians can be gentle and still wise as well as full of power and influence to bring territories and souls to Christ. There are few practical ways Christians can influence a territory:

1. To influence a territory, you must have a voice: Be at the top in the mountain of influence you have been sent to and you shall be heard.

2. Make disciples of all nations (Matt 28:19): The more we raise people in Christ, the higher the number of people who will stand for Him and win more territories to our kingdom.

3. By meeting the needs of others: That is; becoming a problem solver. Some examples of biblical characters who were problem solvers and as such were able to influence their generation include; Joseph, Daniel, Nehemiah, Esther. etc. One another note, anyone you feed must serve your God and as such as we meet the basic needs of people, we can influence them to turn to Christ.

4. By building relationships: You must consciously get to know people and build good relationships. The higher the number of people you know the higher the number of people you can have the opportunity to influence. In fact, in the kingdom who likes you matters. Imagine an affluent business man likes you and you are able to influence him into the kingdom. He will become a financial asset to the kingdom.

In conclusion, influence is a powerful tool that can be used to bring souls and territories unto Christ.

PRAYER: *Father, we thank you for your word today. I pray that you make me more influential in my world and territory for the sake of Christ and the advancement of His kingdom in Jesus' name. Amen.*

THE WEAPON OF MONEY FOR KINGDOM ADVANCEMENT

Ecclesiastes 7:12 For wisdom is a defence, and money is a defence: but the excellency of knowledge is, that wisdom giveth life to them that have it.

Money in itself is not evil for Solomon said in our anchor scripture that it is a defence. Again, in Ec 10:19, Solomon said “**A feast is made for laughter, and wine maketh merry: but money answereth all things**”. The Hebrew word used for **answer** here is “**anah**” which means to **respond or pay attention or heed to**. So, this scripture means that money responds or pay attention to all. It can be a good or bad person, it can be a godly or evil desire, etc. Money responds to anything. It is worthy to mention here why Christians need money.

1. It is God’s will for Christians to have money (3 John 1:2). We are to prosper in all things and this includes money.

2. Money can help Christians to create a sound atmosphere (an atmosphere void of the effects of poverty) to serve God better. In our anchor scripture, Solomon said money is a defence. The Hebrew word used for defence here is “**tsel**” which means a

shade. In other words, money is like a protection or shield we can use against certain earthly inconveniences. Imagine a Christian at the peak of deep worship who gets distracted by a knock on the door just to find out that it is the land lord coming for his house rent.

3. Money is used for Kingdom Advancement: The gospel is free but the means to spread the gospel is not free. We are to take the gospel to all nations and the church cannot do that if we are poor. One cannot walk to China from Ghana to preach the Word. You may have to take a flight which will require money.

In conclusion, in these last days, the gospel will not be only won on our knees but through our pockets. The Church must be rich financially for kingdom advancement.

PRAYER: *Father, we thank you for your word today. My Father, you own all things and you are the one who gives us the power to get wealth. I pray that you cause me to advance financially for the sake of your kingdom in Jesus' name. Amen*

SCATTER YOUR SEEDS

Proverbs 11:24 There is that scattereth, and yet increaseth; and there is that withholdeth more than is meet, but it tendeth to poverty.

In the secular worldview, people think that the only way to have abundance is to gather more. However, in our kingdom the reverse is what brings abundance. Thus, you scatter to have in abundance. This biblical principal thrives on the law of seed time and harvest (***Genesis 8:22 While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease***). This law applies to all things. It is not just limited to money. You can sow seeds of kindness, love, virtues, etc. and they shall be multiplied unto you. In our anchor scripture, Solomon advices us to scatter our seeds across board. Just as farmers sow their seeds in good seasons, I want to suggest to you some practically crucial times ad seasons you must scatter your seeds;

1. ***Special Occasions of your life*** like your birthday, wedding day, wedding anniversary, graduation day, ordination day, etc. These days carry a lifetime memory and it is important to

memorialize these days by sowing seeds. You scatter seeds on these days especially to your parents both spiritual and biological to make their heart merry so they can bless you on these days. These special days are defining moments of your life and you must not celebrate them casually without blessings.

2. ***The Special Occasions of people that matter in your life:*** Just as on your special days like birthday, graduation day, wedding day, etc., I admonished you to scatter seeds, you must also be wise to do same for the people that matter most to you on their special days. These seeds cements relationships and invites blessings into your life. Also, you memorialize your presence/impact in the life of the person because he/she will always remember that special day which you fully represented by your seeds.
3. ***The Special Occasions celebrated worldwide*** like Christmas, New year, Easter, Father's Day, Mother's Day. It is important to scatter your seeds on these days to extend the love of Christ to all men.
4. ***Ordinary days:*** There are ordinary days that the Holy Spirit inspires you to give and you must be conscious of these moments to scatter your seeds.

In conclusion these defining moments should be institutionalized in your life. Let them guide your giving and you will always walk in abundance. Remember that, this principle of scattering your seeds is not limited to money. You can sow seeds for any good thing you want in life whether virtues like love, peace or material

things like cars, houses, etc. You can sow seeds for all the good things you desire and you will receive in abundance.

PRAYER: *Father, we thank you for your word today. Father, help me not to forget to scatter my seeds in every harvest you give me. As I sow seeds consistently, may I live in a perpetual flow of the things I desire to have in life in Jesus' name. Amen.*

THE CONCEPT OF HOPE

1 Corinthians 13:13 And now abideth faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

Hope simply is an expectation for the future. When you hope for something, it practically means that you do not personally have the substance or pattern to bring the unseen or what you wish for into manifestation but you have a certain expectation and believe that will be fulfilled. Thus, with hope you are not the one working but God is working and you are expecting it to be done. This is different from faith where you have a major part to play. Consequently, hope should be applied in situations such as:

1. Certain sovereign activities of God: For instance, the rapture of the Church (***1Cor 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed***). We are waiting for our blessed rapture to be with the Lord. We are expecting it to happen. We do not know how it will be like but we know and hope it is going to happen (the hope of His calling- Eph. 1:18). Another example is how God brought the gift of salvation (***Rom 8:24 For we are saved by hope: but hope that is***

seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?). We did not do any work to be saved, Christ worked everything and gave it to us as a free gift. We are just enjoying His finished works. Glory! With hope you are not the worker but God is the worker. Men hoped for salvation and God brought it as a free gift to us through our Lord Jesus Christ. However, you need faith to enjoy the good things found in this free gift of salvation.

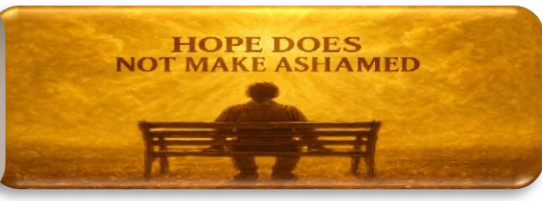
2. Another situation we can apply hope to is when the Spirit makes intercession on our behalf or when the Spirit works on our behalf (Rom 8:26-Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered). Thus, the Spirit works on our behalf and we do not even know what is being done. Actually, the moment the pattern for the work is revealed unto you it is no longer hope then it switches to Faith. Faith deals with precepts and patterns that the Word of God reveals to you and as you do them the Holy Spirit works them out. But with hope, the precepts and patterns are not known to you but you have an expectation that the Holy Spirit will perform it. It is important to know and understand the difference between Faith and Hope so that the things which require Faith in your life you do not exchange them with Hope.

In conclusion, you are to receive and walk in the Finished works of Christ by Faith and not by Hope. This means you need the

precepts and Patterns to work them out. But there are other things that God takes the lead in working and with that you must apply hope to it.

PRAYER: *Father, we thank you for your word today. Father, I put my hope in you for all the good things you have promised us by your Word and prophetic speakings. Even though I do not know how everything will play out but I thank you that the things which requires hope, you are at work bringing them to pass in Jesus' name. Amen.*

HOPE DOES NOT MAKE ASHAMED

Romans 5:1-5 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: 2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. 3 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; 4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope: 5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

In our previous study we looked at the concept of hope and we understood that it is primarily we expecting God to do something whilst faith on the other hand is God expecting us to do something. This explains why when we are hoping for something from God, He gives us assurances that what we are expecting will come to pass. So, for instance God assures us of our expectations in *Jer 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.* Thus, no matter what happens, hope does not make ashamed. Your expectation will not be cut off. God is working something big for you. Hallelujah!

It is worthy to show you here the practical link of our expectation (hope) and our faith. For instance: if you expect to own a house one day in future, this is hope. The moment God speaks to you concerning how this expectation is supposed to happen, then you need to believe the Word and take actions of obedience (this is faith). This is why active fellowship with the Holy Spirit and the Word is important so that God speaks to us on our part to play in the fulfilment of our expectations. The patterns and precepts (substance) of what we hope for are given there. Your alignment to them and living by them is walking in faith.

In conclusion, have hope in God for He is faithful to perform whatever He has promised. Hallelujah!!

PRAYER: *Father, we thank you for your word today. We thank you that hope does not make us ashamed because you are faithful and just to bring to pass every expectation of the righteous in Jesus' name.*

THE HOPE OF HIS CALLING

Ephesians 1:17-18 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: 18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints.

The **“know”** here is from the Greek word **“eido”** which means to be fully aware. It is like receiving a gift package and opening it to see what is there for you (awareness). Same way, there are wonderful things in the free gift of salvation we have received from the Lord. We were called out from darkness into His marvellous Light. God has called us to Himself through our Lord Jesus Christ. It is important then to become fully aware of the glorious hope of His calling. An in-depth knowledge of the hope of His calling can make you laugh at tribulations because you are aware (know) that something glorious awaits you. In fact, not only in this life but in the one which is to come. It is worthy to highlight Apostle Paul’s words here that **“If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable”** (1Cor

15:19). There is a glorious hope of His calling. Apostle John said ***“Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is”*** (1 John 3:2). We shall all be changed. We shall put on glorified bodies. I believe that the saints of old could die happily whilst they were been martyred because they were fully aware of the hope of His calling and that glory awaited them.

In conclusion, no matter the trials and persecutions you go through for the sake of Christ, rejoice for there is a glorious hope awaiting us in Christ Jesus. Be bold, rejoice and do not be afraid to stand for Jesus. Hallelujah!!

OUR LABOR IN HOPE

1 Corinthians 9:9 For it is written in the law of Moses, Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of the ox that treadeth out the corn. Doth God take care for oxen? 10 Or saith he it altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, this is written: that he that ploweth should plow in hope; and that he that thresheth in hope should be partaker of his hope.

We have been called unto good works (Eph 2:10). There is a work and labour for us in the Lord. Labour speaks more of internal effort whilst works speak more of external effort. However, labour precedes work because it is what you have built inside that determines the work you can do on the outside. As Christians, we are to labour (like prayer of intercession) for the salvation of souls and territories and also perform works (like preaching, evangelism, etc.) for the message of salvation to get to them. In our anchor scripture, Apostle Paul assures us by the inspiration of the Spirit that, as we labour and work for the Lord, we should be conscious of the rewards awaiting us. Anyone who labours for the Lord is worthy of his reward (1Timothy 5:18). God is not unrighteous to forget our labour of love. Verily, verily, I say unto

you, thou shall have rewards both on earth and in Heaven. For this hope, labour for the Lord with all your heart and might. Continue living for God and doing His will. Remember the words of Apostle Paul in ***1 Corinthians 15:30 And why stand we in jeopardy every hour? 31 I protest by your rejoicing which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily. 32 If after the manner of men I have fought with beasts at Ephesus, what advantageth it me, if the dead rise not? let us eat and drink; for tomorrow we die.*** Paul was lamenting that if there is no hope for a glorious future why is he paying the price? It would not have made sense for him to have laboured for God the way he did if there was nothing installed for him in the future.

In conclusion, live for the Lord and labour with this hope that there is a glorious future for us in Christ Jesus. Any price you pay for the Lord will not go unrewarded. Hallelujah!!

ENDURING IN HOPE

Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

As Christians, we are to labour for the Lord because we love Him but sometimes, we can only endure in the labour because of the hope of a glorious future. In our anchor scripture, we observe that for the joy that was set before our Lord Jesus (the expectation before him) he endured the cross. Emphatically speaking, His hope for the Glory (at the right hand of God), the name above all names, the King of kings and the Lord of Lords made Him to endure the cross.

Apostle John also reveals this endurance in hope in ***1 John 3:1 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not. 2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for***

we shall see him as he is. 3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure. Apostle John is saying that because of the glorious hope of ***being like him***, we must be able to endure the process of purification. The many constraints and restraints by the Holy Spirit in our lives is because of a glorious hope to present the Church blameless and without spot.

In conclusion, stand for the Lord, endure for Him. He is worth it. If He paid it all for you, you can also endure it all for Him in hope of a glorious future He has promised for you.

CONFESSON: I have the Spirit of God in me. I am constantly under the influence of the Holy Spirit to fulfil the will of God no matter the suffering and pain I must endure. I set my gaze on the glory awaiting me in Christ Jesus. Hallelujah!!

DEFINING FAITH

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

As Christians, we cannot take faith out of our lives. We can live a victorious life through faith. In fact, we are commanded to live by faith. There are a lot of things to talk about when it comes to faith but for the purposes of today's study, we are going to consider the definition of faith.

From our anchor scripture, Paul gives a deep and succinct definition of faith. He calls faith the substance (***the sub-strata, the foundation, the grounds***) of things hoped for. So, for instance; if you are hoping to build a house, faith is the foundation or the grounds or sub-strata or support for that house. Also, the evidence of things not seen means it is the ***title deed*** of the things we are not seeing. When we say title deed, it is a legal term which means a deed or similar document by which the title or rights or ownership to a property is conveyed between parties. So, faith is the title deed for the things you are not seeing. It is just like when you get the title deed for a house and begin to rejoice even when

you have not seen the house. Similarly, when faith stirs up in your heart it is the title deed for whatever thing you are looking for and as such true faith rejoices before it sees the physical manifestation of the things unseen.

In conclusion, the subject of faith is pivotal in our Christian walk for the Bible says in **Hebrews 11:6** ***But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.*** Understand faith and live by faith for a victorious Christian life. Hallelujah!!

HOW FAITH COMES

Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

In our previous study we understood how faith is the substance of things hoped for. However, you must understand that the substance for building our faith is the Word of God.

In our anchor scripture, Paul shows us how to generate faith which is by hearing (which also means to perceive). He further points to the fact that this perception should be based on the Word of God. Thus, how the Word declares things to be is what we must believe and rely on.

So, as the Word of God is revealed unto you it stirs up faith in your heart and your response to the Word is faith at work. This determines whether the Word will bear fruit or not. We must believe and receive the Word of God for ourselves. For instance, if you are feeling headache and the active Word of God (rhema) stirs up in your heart that you are healed by his stripes, you must exercise yourself in faith and declare the same thing and act accordingly. Thus, you must begin to do what you couldn't do

because of the headache you were feeling. This act of obedience to the Word that has been stirred in your heart is the step of faith. Faith in operation is simply acting out the Word of God.

In conclusion, you must be full of the Word through meditation so that when you are confronted with any situation the Holy Spirit can stir the Word in your heart to produce the faith the works.

LIVING BY FAITH

Hebrews 10:38 Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

In our previous study, we understood how the Word of God is the raw material for building our faith. In our anchor scripture for today's study, we are charged by Apostle Paul through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit to live by faith. Since faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God, it is important to note here that, living by faith may simply mean living by what the Word of God says and not what the flesh or the world or the majority say. You must see things the way the Word of God defines them to be. Your perception of things must be based on the Word of God. You must be able to renew your mind by the Word of God to see how things ought to be in Christ. Then your perception and imaginations of life will be based on what God desires. As a Christian, you must not live by your senses but by faith. People who live by their senses focus their minds only on logic and what the world is saying. Do not be carnally minded (***Romans 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be***

spiritually minded is life and peace). Renew your sensory perception by the Word and see rightly God's way.

When you live by faith, you literally walk in limitless possibilities (***Mark 9:23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth***).

In conclusion, just agree with what the Word of God is saying and see the power of God at work in His Word. Remember that, wherever the Word is, the power of God is there to perform.

THE SPEAKINGS OF FAITH

Colossians 4:13 We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak.

In today's study we will learn one important practice that can stir up your faith daily and this key is the speakings of faith. Anytime you begin to speak the Word it is your agreement to the Word. Your mouth was not given to you for just eating. What you speak is what you get. Remember in our previous devotional booklet the wonderful teachings on meditation. Meditation on the Word is what gets the Word into you. This is different from the speakings of faith. The speakings of faith are the confessions we make because of the Word of God that has entered us through meditation. In other words, meditation gets the Word into us whilst confession gets the Word out of us. You must begin to speak rightly what the Word of Gods says about you. The words you speak are spirit and life. Build your life by your confessions.

In our previous study, we understood the speakings of faith and how it reveals our agreement with the Word of God. You must understand that as you continue to speak the word it makes you do what it is saying. Thus, you get to a point where you become so emotionally attached to your confessions that it stirs you up to perform the actions necessary for manifesting what you believe. Inevitably, your actions reflect what you speak. You must live by your confessions.

In our anchor scripture, James makes a remarkable statement that faith without works is dead. This understanding is crucial for any Christian who wants to live by faith. The actions of obedience because of what you believe is the vital force behind the manifestation of your confessions. The Holy Spirit moves when you are obedient to His instructions through faith. There are times that what the Word tells you may be contrary to what you feel but

you must not be weak in faith to not carry out that action. You must learn to trust and obey God even when it does not make human sense. You are not supposed to be necessarily logical as a Christian but you must emphatically be always scriptural.

In conclusion, what gives life to your faith are the actions of obedience. Revive your faith today by taking actions according to the Word of God and there shall surely be a performance. Hallelujah!!!

Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

In our previous study we understood how our actions of obedience gives life to our speakings of faith. In today's study we will consider a very crucial part of our journey of faith which has to do with the motive behind the expression of our faith.

As we desire to walk in faith, it is expedient that we know that love should be the motivation of whatever we do in the kingdom. No matter how powerful your faith is, if it lacks love it is baseless. Recall the words of Apostle Paul in ***1 Corinthians 13:2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.***

There are some Christians who desire to walk in faith but their motive is for vain glory. They just want to make a public show of their so called 'spirituality'. This motive for expressing faith deviates from its default atmosphere in which we are to practice our faith. Love should motivate our actions.

So, to walk in true biblical faith continuously, you must be a lover of God and a lover of others. Let love have her perfect way in you and see how you will cheaply walk in faith.

In conclusion, God looks at the motives of our heart in whatever we do in the kingdom. Have the right motive for whatever you do in the kingdom especially in your demonstration of faith.

1 John 4:19 We love him, because he first loved us.

It is important therefore to quickly spell out God's love for man in ***John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.*** God so loved us to give us His only son.

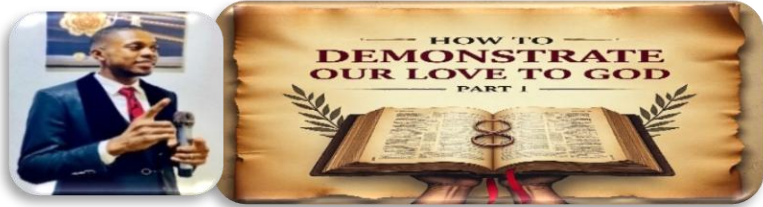

HOW TO DEMONSTRATE OUR LOVE TO GOD: PART 1

1 John 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. 1 John 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

In our previous study we understood how a revelation of God's love for us gives us a good basis to love God. In today's study, I want to share with you some basic practical ways of demonstrating our love to God.

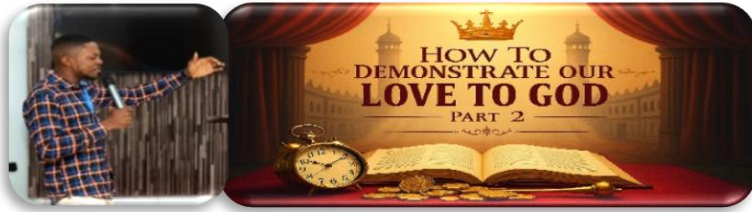
1. The first basic way to demonstrate your love to God is by your absolute submission and obedience to the Word of God as revealed by Apostle John in our anchor scripture. On another note, in Apostle Paul's teaching concerning marriage in Ephesians 5:22-32, he shows how the wife is expected to submit to the husband. The Church which is the bride of Christ is expected to do likewise. I believe that, a woman who cannot submit to her husband and always does power struggle with him does not truly love him (in fact that is how the husband will always feel that he is not loved). Submission is

proof of love and that is why the wife was not instructed to love but to submit as the proof of her love to her husband. Likewise, as the bride of Christ we are to submit to Him such that His will becomes our pleasure to obey. In ***John 4:34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.*** Jesus' meat means his satisfaction, his joy, his pleasure, his dream, his obsession, etc and the Bible says his meat is do the will of God. Can you also say this to the LORD?

In conclusion, we can demonstrate our love to God through submission and obedience. It is expedient to do this fully as proof of our love. No command should be too grievous to carry if we love Him.

HOW TO DEMONSTRATE OUR LOVE TO GOD: PART 2

In our previous study we learnt one practical way of demonstrating our love to God and in today's study we will consider another practical key.

2. You demonstrate your love to God by being passionate about His Kingdom on the earth. The love Jesus had for the Father lead to ***John 2:17 And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up.*** Indeed, this was written in ***Psalms 69:9 For the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up; and the reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me.*** Lovers of God are passionate about God's house and by extension his kingdom. One way to be passionate about God's kingdom is to invest your treasures into the kingdom (***Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also***). When we look at your treasures (your time, strength, intellect, talents, gifts, abilities, skills, resources, substance, body, assets, money, emotions, etc.) that you use for the kingdom, we can know where your heart is. Inevitably, we come to know the extent

of the love you have for God. If your heart is with the Lord your treasures must be seen there also.

In conclusion, continue to demonstrate your love to God by being so zealous in promoting His Kingdom. Use all that **you are** and all that **you have** to passionately promote the kingdom of God. This is a practical way of loving God. Hallelujah!!

LOVE AS A VIRTUE

Col 3:12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; 13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. 14 And above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfectness.

In our anchor scripture, the phrase “**above all**” is like an upper garment. So, putting on love which is the bond of perfection (completeness) means that love unites all the other virtues to create a harmony. Harmony is the positive combination of different things.

Love is the binding agent for walking in these virtues; *bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering, forgiveness, etc.* Love is a powerful virtue that God requires that we manifest. Indeed, a man full of love is a man full of God for God is love. When you walk with the Holy Spirit, He works on you to fully manifest the character and nature of the Father which

is love. A close walk with the Holy Spirit makes you a man of love.

In conclusion, virtues easily flow out of us if they fill us to the brim. Our lives can be fully filled with the virtue of love such that when people get close to us, they feel the love of the Father.

PRAYER: *Father, I thank you for your word today. I thank you for the privilege to have your nature of love as your children. As I grow and manifest this virtue of love, use me to extend your love to a dying world in Jesus' name. Amen.*
